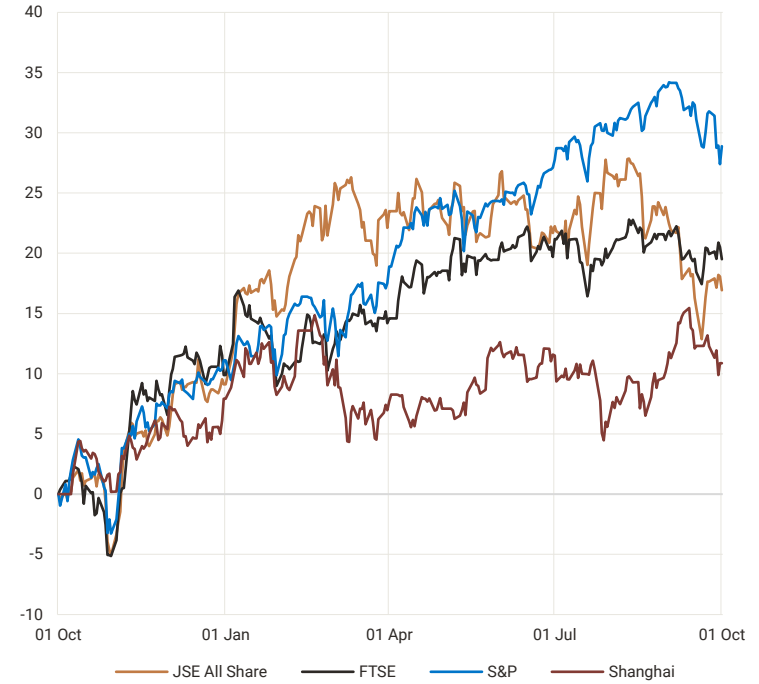

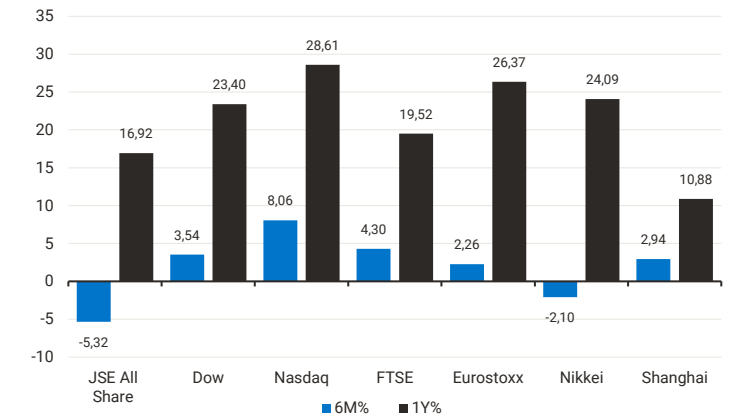

Local stocks fell tracking moves in global shares on Friday. The Top-40 index closed 1.03% lower at 57,265.62 while the broader all-share was down 0.97% to 63,661.02. Recent domestic data has been better than predicted and the economy performed strongly in the first half of the year. Still, the central bank said last week that it thought the bounce-back from the COVID-19 pandemic was mostly done. Data on Friday showed South African manufacturing activity improved in September but at a slower pace than August.

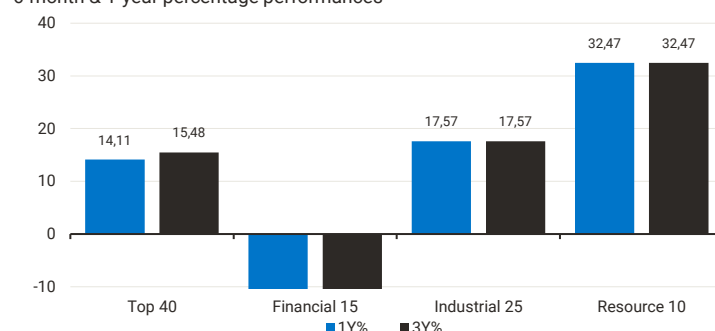
JSE TOP 40 INDEX

PIC's externalised assets grew 31% in the year to March

The Public Investment Corporation's (PIC's) externalised assets grew by 31% to R395 billion at the end of March 2021. This was up from R301 billion in March 2020 according to the PIC's annual report released last week. The asset manager attributed most of these gains to the performance of global and domestic equities, which significantly outperformed other asset classes from an absolute return perspective over its financial year. The PIC's external managers comprise eight global and 20 domestic firms that manage R178 billion and R217 billion respectively. The PIC, South Africa's biggest asset manager and wholly-owned by the government, also announced that its total assets under management (AUM) for the financial year ended March 31, 2021 grew by almost R440 billion to R2.3 trillion. The asset manager's listed equities division grew its AUM by 51.4% over the 12 months ended March 2021 to R838 billion. The PIC's listed investments portfolio outperformed the composite index over the three years ended March 2021 by 0.21% cumulatively, the asset manager said. PIC chief executive Abel Sithole wrote: "This performance is a demonstration that the PIC's diversified investment strategy works. On its bond portfolio, the PIC fixed-income team bought conventional bonds and inflation-linked bonds in response to the rising yields, mostly in quarter one and quarter two of 2020. "The bond purchases at higher yields and subsequent bond market rally during the period under review contributed to the outperformance of PIC internally managed conventional bond funds against the FTSE/JSE All Bond index benchmark," the PIC wrote. The PIC said the investment outlook remained "highly uncertain" one year into the Covid-19 pandemic. "New virus mutations and the accumulating human toll are concerning, even as growing vaccine coverage lifts sentiment. Economic recoveries are diverging across countries and sectors, reflecting variation in pandemic-induced disruptions and the extent of policy support. The International Monetary Fund projects global growth at 6% in 2021, moderating to 4.4% in 2022. Listed property companies will be negatively affected as rentals come under further pressure, reducing asset values and increasing balance sheet risk.

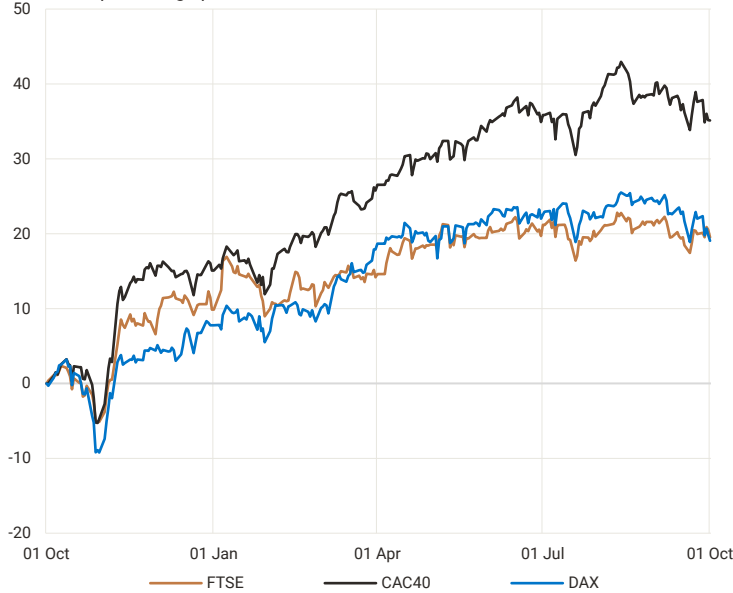

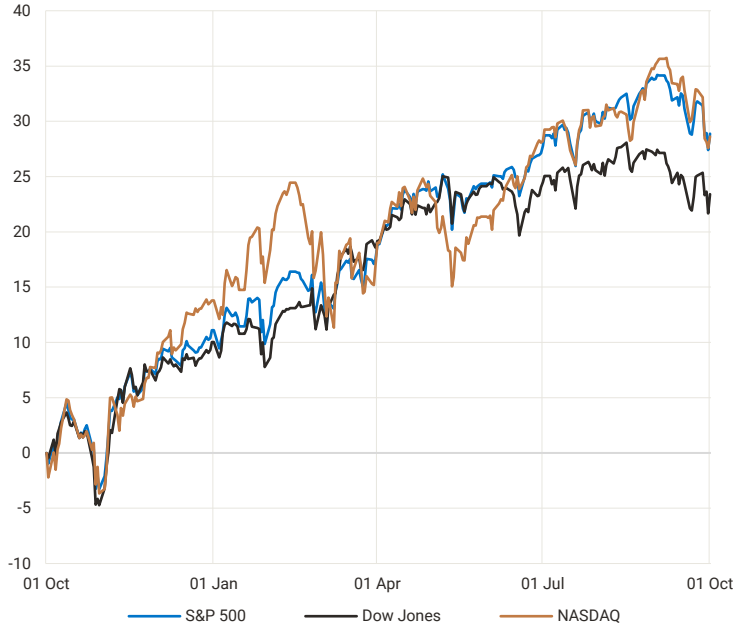

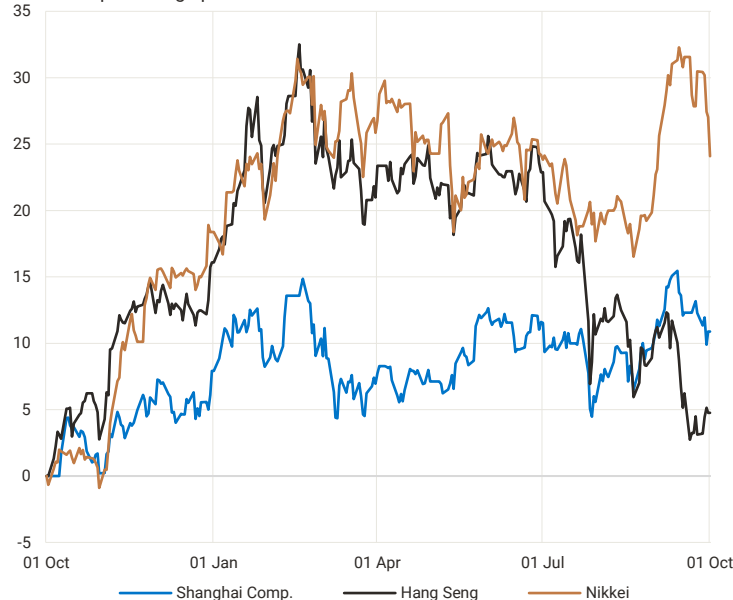

European stock markets closed lower on Friday as economic data showed euro zone inflation jumped to a 13-year high. The pan-European Stoxx 600 closed down by 0.4%, recouping some of its earlier losses having been down as much as 1.7% at the start of trading. Mining stocks slipped 1.3% to lead losses while travel and leisure shares jumped 3%. Euro zone inflation in September rose 3.4% on an annual basis, official data showed Friday, the highest reading since September 2008 and up from 3% in August.

U.S. stocks pushed higher on Friday as investors shook off a rough September and news of a new oral treatment for Covid-19 boosted shares of companies tied to the economic recovery. Shares of Dow member Merck jumped close to 8.4% after the drug maker and Ridgeback Biotherapeutics said their oral antiviral treatment for Covid-19 reduced the risk of hospitalization or death by 50% for patients with mild or moderate cases. The companies plan to seek emergency authorization for the treatment.

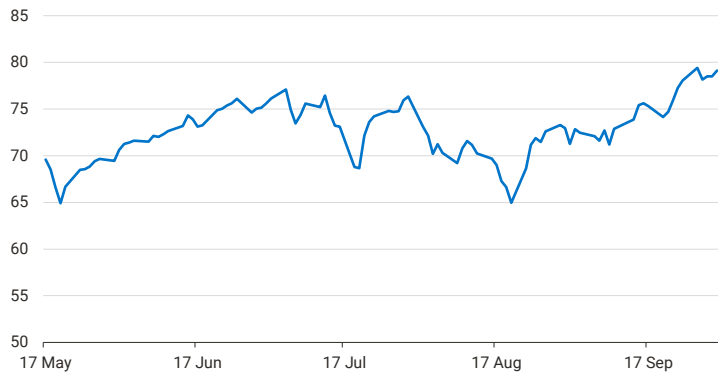

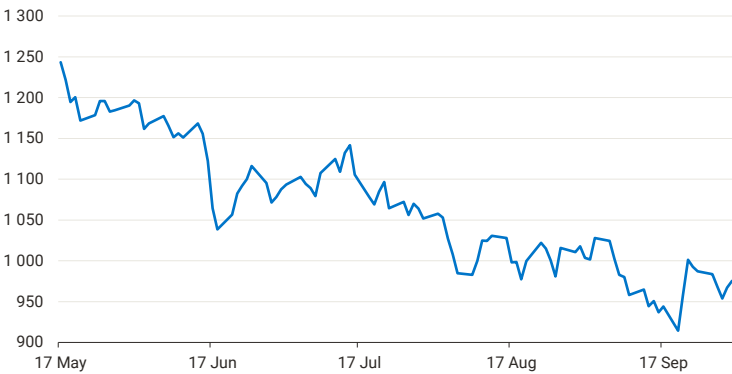

Gold prices hit a near two-week peak this morning, as a weaker dollar offset bets that the U.S. Federal Reserve could begin tapering its pandemic-era asset purchases soon. Oil fell earlier today ahead of an OPEC+ supply policy meeting that may decide whether a recent rally in prices can be sustained as the world fitfully recovers from the COVID-19 pandemic. Oil prices have risen amid supply disruptions and recovering global demand, pushing Brent last week to an almost three-year high above \$80.

The rand rose against an easing dollar on Friday, erasing some of the losses suffered in the week as currency markets braced for a rise in U.S. interest rates. At the close of the session, the rand was trading around the R14.88 mark versus the dollar, 1.16% firmer. The rand slipped to a more than five-week low of 15.2500 this week as COVID-19 concerns, wobbles in China's growth and a Washington gridlock ahead of a looming deadline to lift the U.S. government's borrowing limit, lent support to the dollar which is seen as a safe-haven asset.
