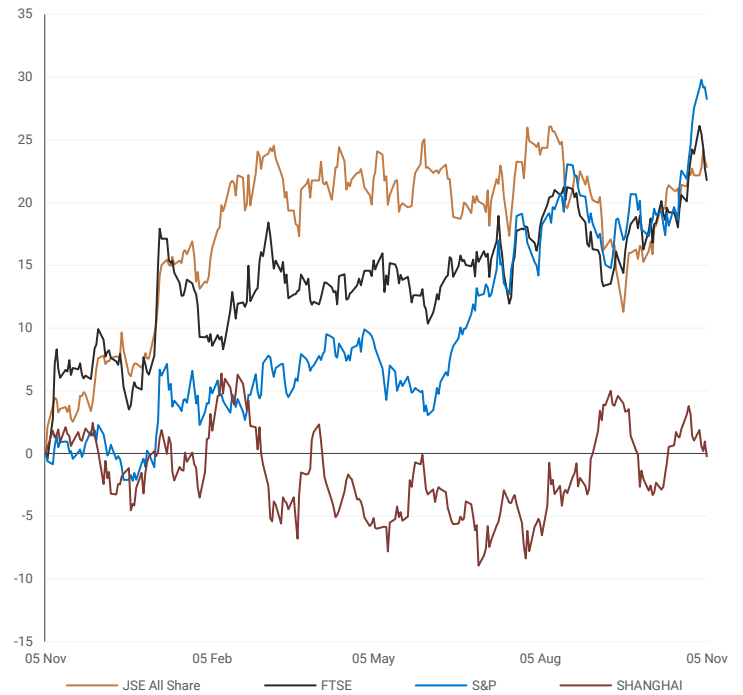

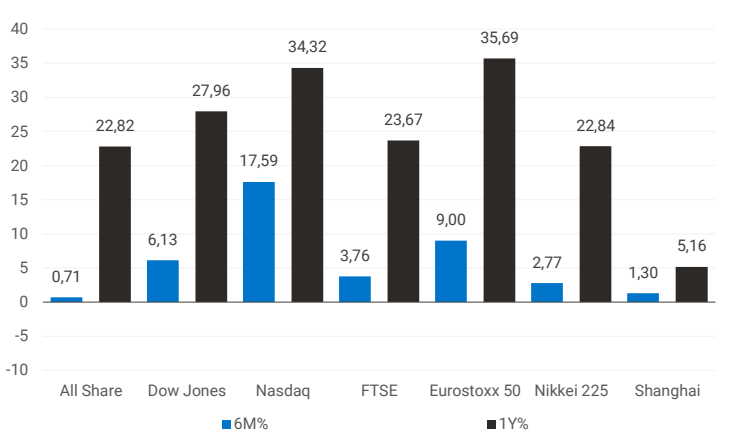

Technology stocks weighed on the Johannesburg Stock Exchange's Top-40 Index. It fell 0.48% and the broader All-Share Index closed down 0.49%. The tech index fell 3.24%, led by market heavyweights Naspers and its subsidiary Prosus which both fell more than 3%. Bucking the downward trend was MTN, which jumped 13.15% after Africa's biggest mobile operator by subscribers got in-principal approval to operate its mobile money service MoMo in Nigeria. In fixed income, the yield on the benchmark 2030 government bond was down 6 basis points to 9.45%.

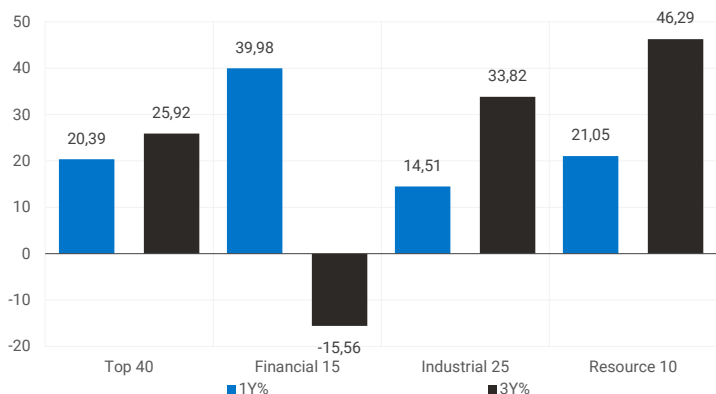
JSE TOP 40 INDEX

Purple Group's earnings expected to shoot up by more than 180%

Purple Group expects a basic earnings per share and a headline earnings per share of between 4.38 cents and 4.54 cents in the twelve months ended August 31 compared to earnings per share of 1.54 cents reported in the prior period, representing an increase of between 185% and 195%. The financial services and technology group said in a trading statement issued on Friday that attributable profit improved from R14.4 million in the prior period to between R43.5 million and R45.0 million for the current period. EasyEquities' profit which will see a staggering climb of between 676% and 703%, translating into an attributable profit of between R54.5 million and R56.4 million for Purple Group shareholders, compared to R6 million in the prior period. Due to GT247.com's difficult trading year, it has generated an attributable loss of between R5.1 million and R5.3 million for the period, compared to the attributable profit of R18.4 million in the prior period. mperor Asset Management expects an attributable profit for the period to be between R0.95 million and R0.99 million, compared to the profit of R1.9 million in the prior period. The company's results for the 12 months ended August 31, 2021 are expected to be published on Sens on or around November 10, 2021.

Pepkor's 2021 headline earnings per share expected to rise over 94%

Pepkor expects its headline earnings per share (Heps) for the financial year to September 30, 2021, will increase by 94.7% to 114.7% (127.5 cents to 140.6 cents). In its trading statement on Friday Pepkor ascribed the increase to several factors, including an improved trading performance compared with FY20, which was impacted by the Covid-19 trading restrictions; as well as reduced finance costs, due to a marked reduction in the company's net debt and impairment charges recognised during FY20 which specifically impacted earnings per share. Another factor was the lease modification gains in terms of IFRS 16 as a result of favourable lease renewals and retail footprint consolidation in specific retail brands. "The acquisition of a portfolio of leased properties as announced on April 14 on Sens resulted in the derecognition of related right-of-use assets and lease liabilities," the group said. The share has climbed steadily over the past year and is up almost 90% year-to-date after falling in 2020.

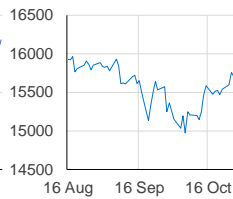
European markets closed marginally higher on Friday as investors reacted to promising news on Pfizer's Covid-19 pill and a strong U.S. jobs report. The pan-European Stoxx 600 closed up by just 0.05% with most sectors finishing in the black. On the data front, euro zone September retail sales posted a surprise drop, according to Eurostat data on Friday, sliding 0.3% month-on-month as weakness in Germany weighed on the bloc.

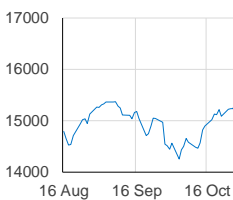
U.S. stocks rallied to record levels on Friday after the October jobs report came in better than expected, boosting optimism about the economic recovery. The move for stocks came as data showed job gains for the month of October totalled 531,000. Consensus estimates called for 450,000 jobs added, according to Dow Jones. The report also revised September's disappointing number up to 312,000 job gains from 194,000 previously, and increased its August number by a similar amount. Pfizer shares surged nearly 11% after the company said its Covid-19 drug, used with an HIV drug, cut the risk of hospitalization by 89%.

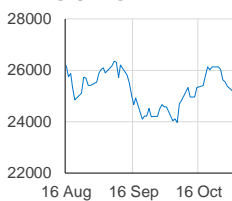

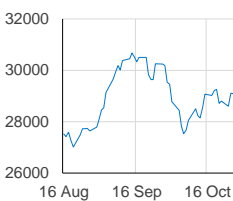

Official data released over the weekend showed China's exports surging 27.1% in October as compared with a year ago. That was higher than the 24.5% growth forecast by analysts in a Reuters poll. The Australian stock market is modestly lower in choppy trading, shedding some of the gains in the previous three sessions.

Oil prices rose earlier this morning after Saudi Arabia's state-owned oil producer Aramco raised the official selling price for its crude, suggesting demand remains strong at a time of tighter supplies. The Organization of the Petroleum Exporting Countries and allies such as Russia, together known as OPEC+, agreed last week to stick to their plan to raise oil output by 400,000 barrels per day from December. Gold prices extended a rally to hit a two-month high today as a retreating dollar bolstered the precious metal's appeal.

The rand firmed on Friday along with other emerging market currencies after a volatile week with price swings driven by domestic politics and U.S. monetary policy. At the close of the session, the rand was trading around R15.04 to the dollar, 1.11% firmer. The rand was supported by strong U.S. jobs data, which boosted optimism about the global economic recovery. The rand's gains were capped, however, by a poor showing by the governing African National Congress (ANC) in municipal elections.

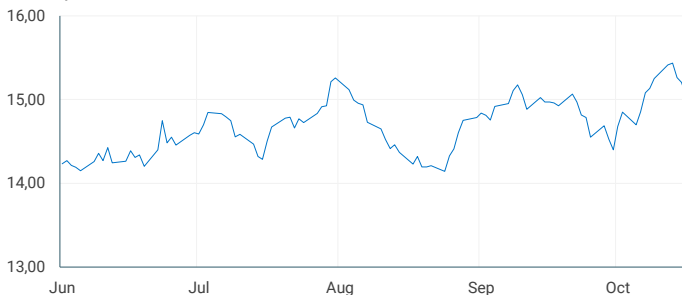
