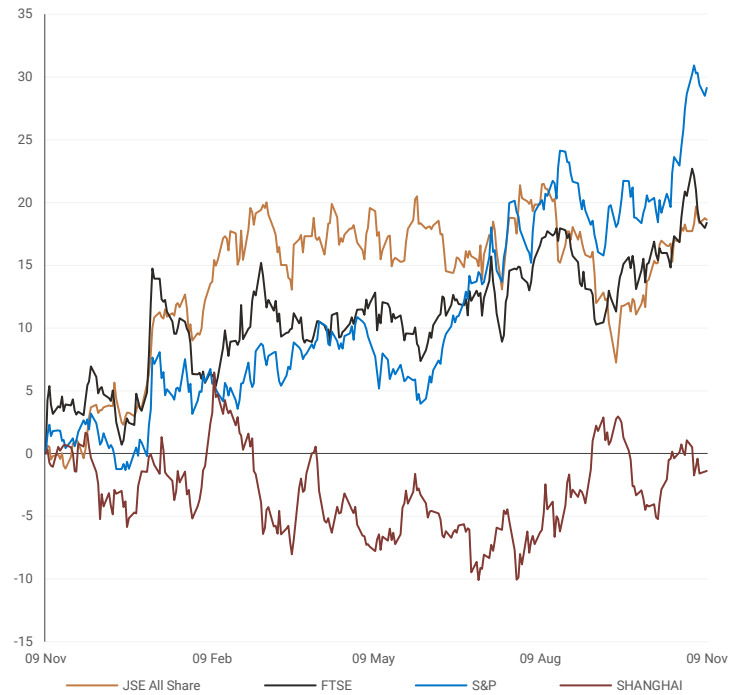

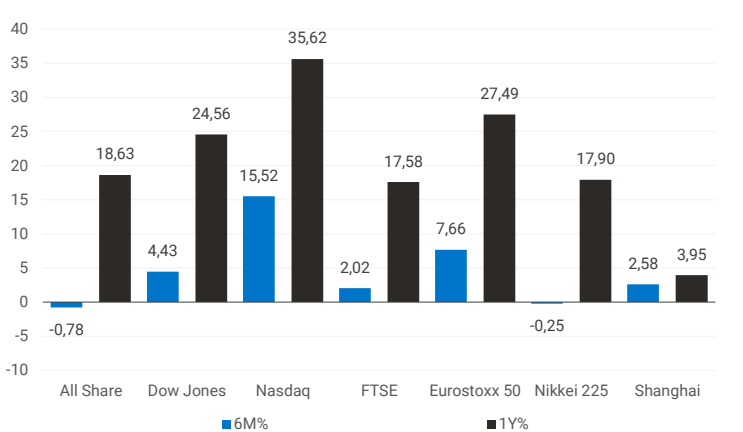

Shares in telecoms firm Telkom closed over 12% lower after the company reported weaker than expected results at its mobile business. Local investors will also be watching finance minister Enoch Godongwana's maiden Medium-Term Budget Policy Statement (MTBPS) expected on Thursday, outlining estimated budget deficits and economic growth forecast over the next three years.

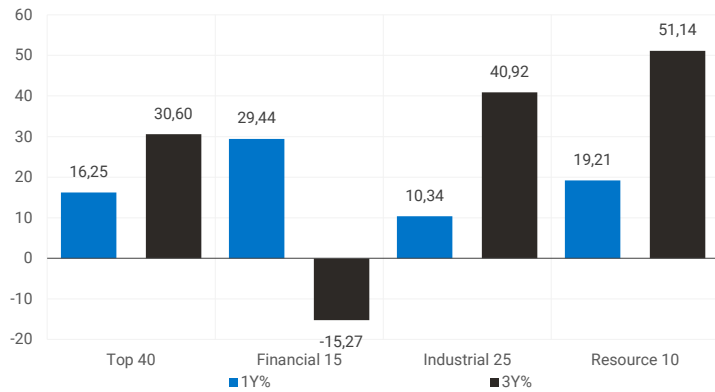
JSE TOP 40 INDEX

Northam outfoxes Impala Platinum with R17bn Royal Bafokeng deal

Revealing the deal in a Sens statement, Waterfall City-headquartered Northam said that it had signed a sale of shares agreement on Monday, November 8, with Royal Bafokeng Holdings Proprietary Limited (RBH) and Royal Bafokeng Investment Holding Company Proprietary Limited (RBIH), which will see it acquiring up to 33.3% of all the RBPlat ordinary shares in issue. RBIH is a wholly owned subsidiary of RBH. The move comes just two weeks after Implats and RBPlat jointly announced that talks were underway for Implats to acquire 100% of the issued ordinary shares of RBPlat. "Northam will acquire 93 930 378 RBPlat shares from RBIH, amounting to 32.8% of the RBPlat net shares, for an aggregate purchase consideration of [circa] R17 billion representing R180.50 per RBPlat share," the group noted in its Sens statement on Tuesday morning. "The parties have entered into a put and call option arrangement in terms of which Northam may acquire a further 0.5% of the RBPlat net shares for a purchase consideration of R135 per RBPlat share. Should the RBIH put and call option be exercised in full, Northam will acquire 33.3% of the RBPlat net shares in aggregate," it added. Meanwhile, in separately posted Sens statements on Tuesday Implats and RBPlats announced the withdrawal of the cautionary related to Implats's non-binding 100% buyout offer. "Implats shareholders are referred to the joint cautionary announcement released on Sens by the company and RBPlat on 27 October 2021 and the withdrawal of cautionary published by RBPlat today, 9 November 2021, in terms of which RBPlat stated that it has been informed by its single largest shareholder RBH that it is no longer supportive of the transaction referred to in the joint cautionary announcement and that in so far as it holds shares in RBPlat, it will vote against the proposed scheme of arrangement referred to in the joint cautionary announcement," Implats noted in its latest Sens.

Home fibre leaps past copper in Telkom's network

The number of active fibre-to-the-home connections in Telkom's network has leapt past the number of legacy copper connections. This as the company continues with an aggressive decommissioning of its copper infrastructure. Telkom said on Tuesday alongside its interim results for the six months to end-September 2021 that the number of homes passed with fibre increased by 54.2% year on year to reach reach 707 399. The number of homes actually connected to this fibre infrastructure increased by 34.3% to 331 735. At the same time, the number of homes connected to copper declined to just 230 817. Total fixed broadband subscribers declined to 562 552 at end-September, from 637 884 a year earlier. The total number of fixed access lines plunged 21.9% to just 1.1 million. There was a big spike in capital expenditure on the fibre network, rising 297% year on year. Overall, capex rose 22.7% to R3.6 billion, with the biggest share going to mobile. Openseive, the wholesale division in Telkom responsibility for network deployment and maintenance, continued to stabilise, Telkom said, with its top line revenue slightly down by 1.8% to R6.7 billion in the six-month period.

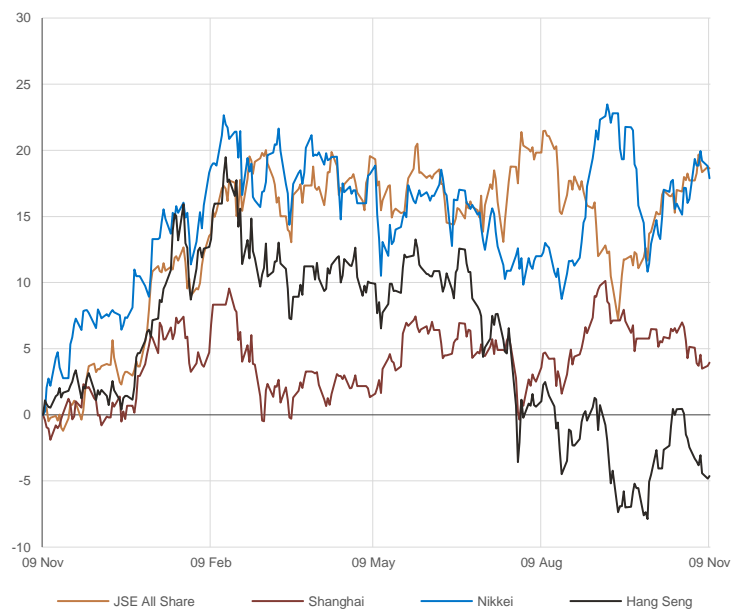

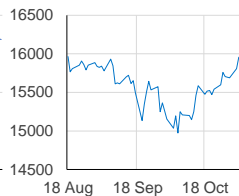
European stocks closed lower Tuesday, as investors assessed a key reading of U.S. inflation data. The pan-European Stoxx 600 closed down by 0.2% provisionally, having earlier been in positive territory. Basic resources shares slid 1.2%, while the retail sector was up 1.2%. On the data front, Germany's ZEW survey of economic sentiment vastly outstripped expectations in November, coming in at 31.7 against a forecast of 20.0.

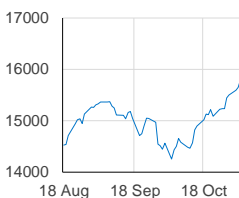
The S&P 500 closed lower Tuesday for the first time in nine sessions as investors took some profits after an October rally and awaited key inflation data ahead. All three major averages dipped from record highs. The S&P 500 on Monday posted its 64th record close of the year and eighth straight positive day – its longest winning streak since April 2019. The October producer price index increased 0.6% month over month, the Labor Department said Tuesday, in line with the Dow Jones consensus estimate. Still, wholesale prices jumped 8.6% in October from a year ago, the hottest annual pace on record in nearly 11 years.

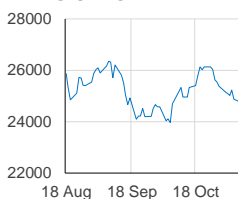

Shares in Asia-Pacific were mixed this morning as investors reacted to the release of Chinese inflation data for October. Hong Kong's Hang Seng index dropped 0.37%, with shares of Chinese real estate firm Fantasia Holdings plunging more than 48% after returning to trade. Fantasia – whose Hong Kong-listed stock was suspended for more than a month – failed to repay a \$206 million bond that matured early October. China's consumer inflation for October came in roughly in line with expectations, according to official data released earlier today.

Oil prices rose this morning, extending strong gains in the previous session, after industry data showed U.S. crude stocks unexpectedly fell last week just as near-term travel demand picked up with pandemic curbs easing. Tightening global oil inventories have supported strong crude prices during the past several months, and the latest data from the American Petroleum Institute reinforced the view that supply remains constrained. Gold prices slipped from a more than two-month peak on Wednesday, as an uptick in the dollar hurt the bullion's appeal.

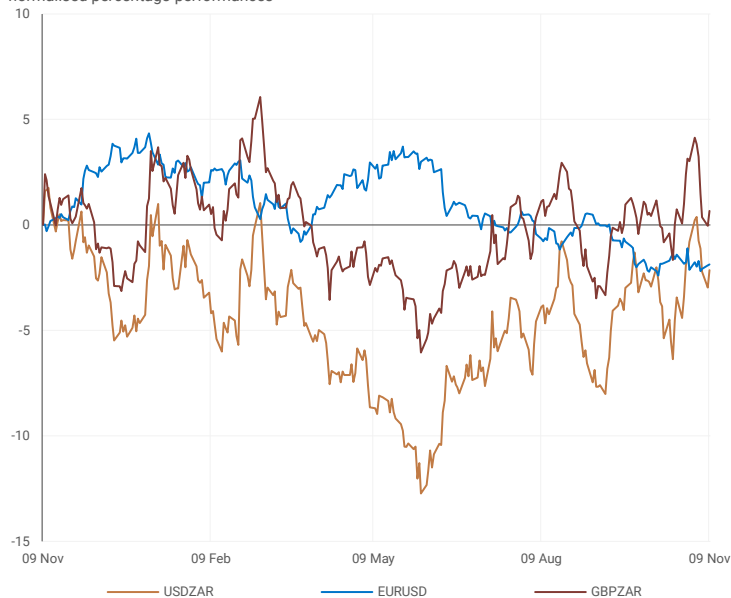

The rand dropped back on Tuesday, losing ground won earlier in the week, as damaging local power cuts were scheduled to continue until the weekend and investors awaited key U.S. inflation data to gauge the Federal Reserve's next move. 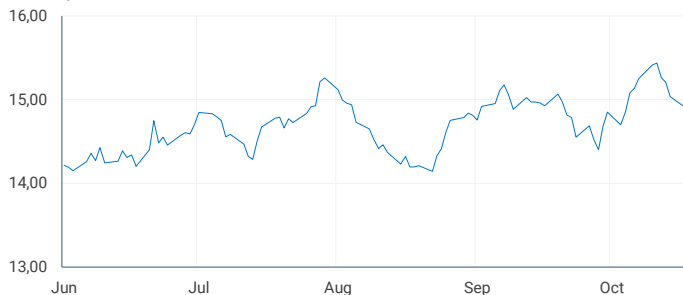
