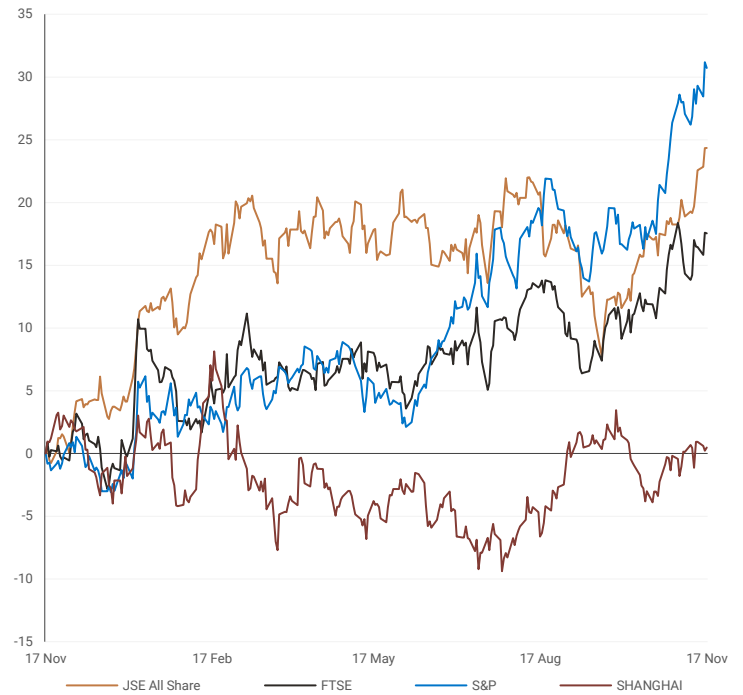

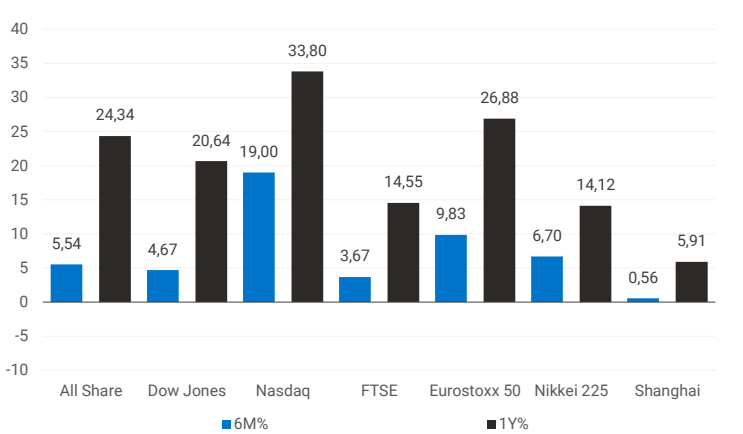

Investors' focus will firmly shift to the South African Reserve Bank's (SARB) monetary policy committee meeting today. In terms of individual share performances, Fortress REIT B and Reunert added 7.21% and 5.37% respectively. At the bottom of the All-Share components was Libstar and Spar, which shed 7.89% and 7.32%.

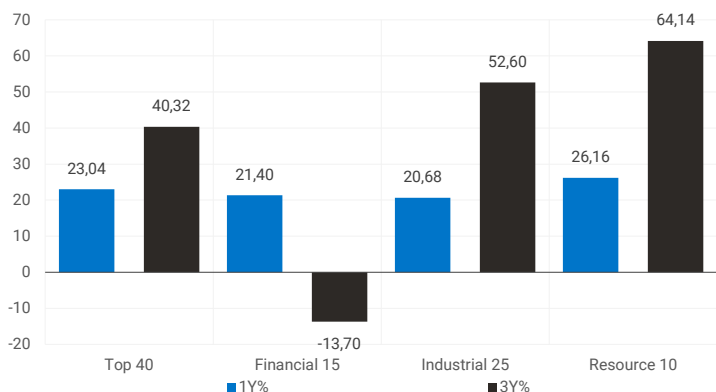
JSE TOP 40 INDEX

Spar slides over 7% on weak full-year performance

The share price of Spar – SA's second largest listed supermarket group – fell more than 7% on Wednesday after the company posted a weak 2021 financial performance for its full-year ended September 30. While the group described the "robust performance" despite "numerous challenges" during the year, the market reacted to the fact that it only managed to muster turnover growth of 2.9% (to R127.9 billion). "The mixed performance across regions delivered group operating profit of R3.4 billion, down 1.5% on the prior period," the group noted in its Sens results statement. "In constant currency, turnover increased by 3.9%, highlighting the impact of the strengthening rand on the current period," it said. Spar's diluted headline earnings per share increased by 5.5% to 1 193.7 cents, while the group declared a final dividend of 536 cents per share. Spar noted that its Southern Africa business contributed growth in wholesale turnover of 3.4%, to R81.3 billion, however its core (like-for-like) wholesale food business sales declined by 0.4%. Meanwhile, Spar said the Build it division delivered an outstanding performance, with wholesale turnover up 23.5%, driven by the continued rural home development and urban home improvement spend. "During the period, the total Southern African store network grew to 2 440 stores, with 26 net new stores opened across all brands, heavily impacted by the closure of 53 stores due to the civil unrest which remained closed at year end [September 2021]," it pointed out.

Tongaat Hulett tanks over 20% after announcing plans for a capital raise

Sugar producer and major property owner Tongaat Hulett saw its share price tank over 20% around midday on Wednesday after the group announced plans for a capital raise on the JSE. The stock initially tanked almost 33% on the news. Tongaat Hulett did not reveal the amount of equity capital to be raised, saying in a statement that the pricing of the rights offer is yet to be determined. However, the group points out that the move "is expected to allow the company to reduce debt to sustainable levels. It says the "proposed major recapitalisation via a rights offer of new shares" will be partially underwritten by Mauritian-based Magister Investments Limited, a shareholder and strategic partner of the group. "The timing to complete the proposed equity raise is dependent upon when the required shareholder, lender and regulatory approvals are obtained, but is expected to be Q1 calendar year 2022," it says.

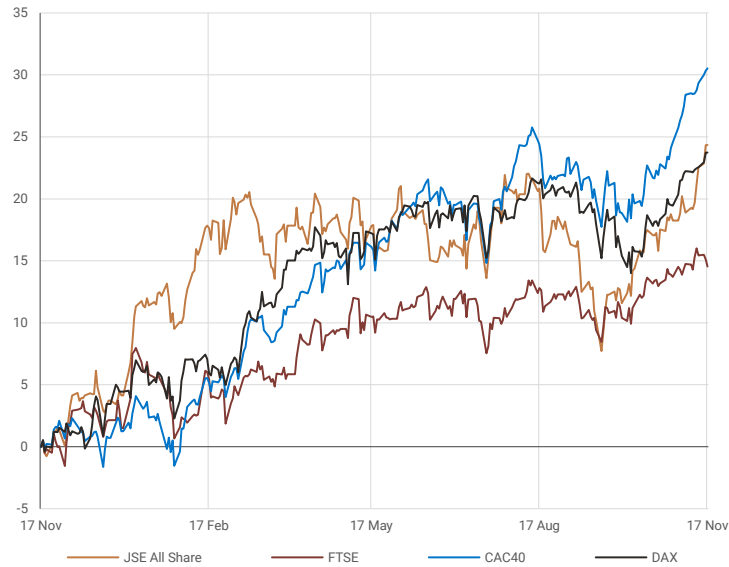

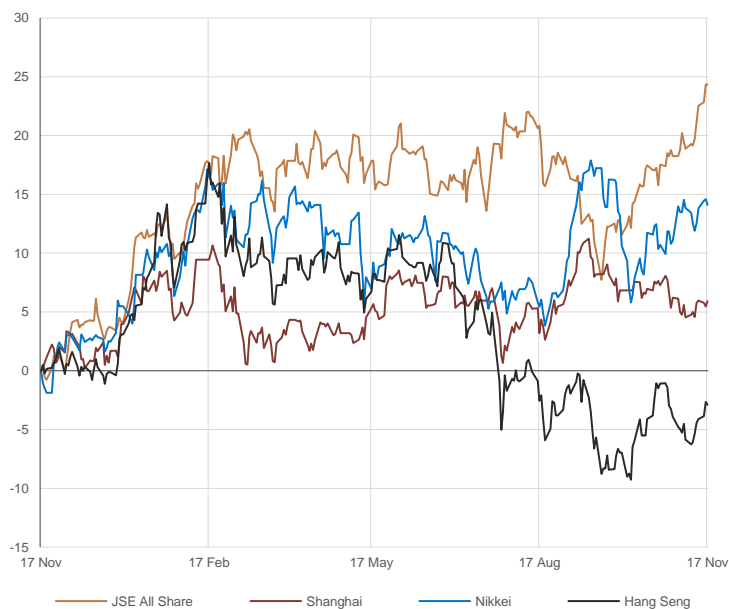

European stocks closed slightly higher on Wednesday as investors reacted to inflation data and a fresh batch of corporate earnings. The pan-European Stoxx 600 provisionally closed up by 0.2%, with mining stocks gaining 1.2% while travel and leisure stocks dropped 1.6%. Euro zone inflation was confirmed at 4.1% year-on-year in October, more than double the European Central Bank's target. U.K. consumer price index (CPI) inflation came in at an annual 4.2% in October, its highest for almost a decade, with energy and automotive costs soaring.

U.S. stocks took a dip on Wednesday as investors weighed a continuation of strong earnings reports from big-box retailers against lingering inflation concerns. Retail giant Target posted beats on the top and bottom lines, but its CEO noted rising costs may have an impact on the company going forward as it plans to absorb those costs rather than pass them onto the customer. Visa shares slid after Amazon said it will stop accepting payments made with Visa credit cards issued in the U.K. starting next year. That change came shortly after Visa raised its interchange fees for transactions between the U.K. and European Union.

Gold prices edged up this morning, as the dollar eased and U.S. bond yields retreated from a three-week high, lifting bullion's appeal. Oil prices declined in the previous session amid growing concerns about oversupply and a recovery in demand. China's state reserve bureau said this morning it is working on a release of crude oil reserves although it declined to comment on a U.S. request to the world's top consuming nations to tap stockpiles to ease global energy prices. The National Food and Strategic Reserves Administration told Reuters when asked to comment on the U.S. request that it would disclose the details of the move on its website.

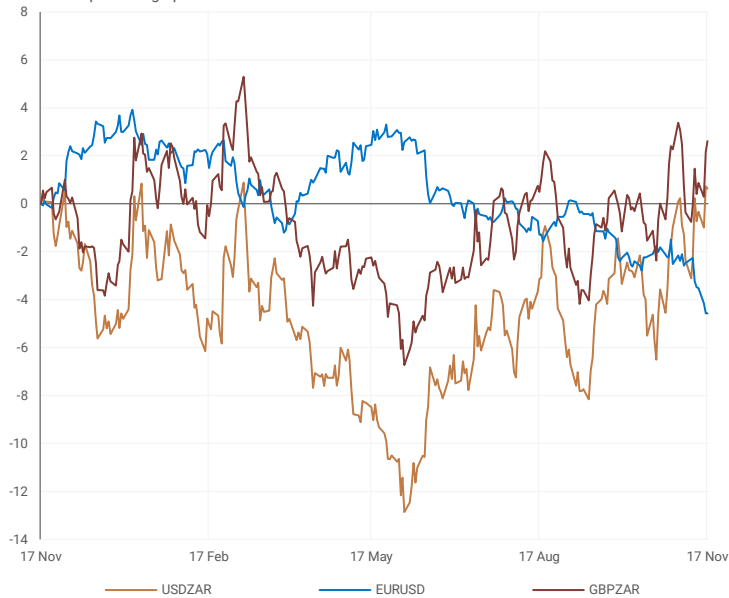
