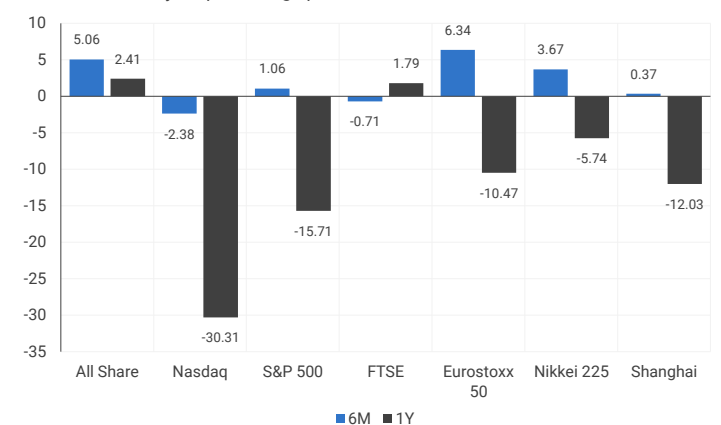

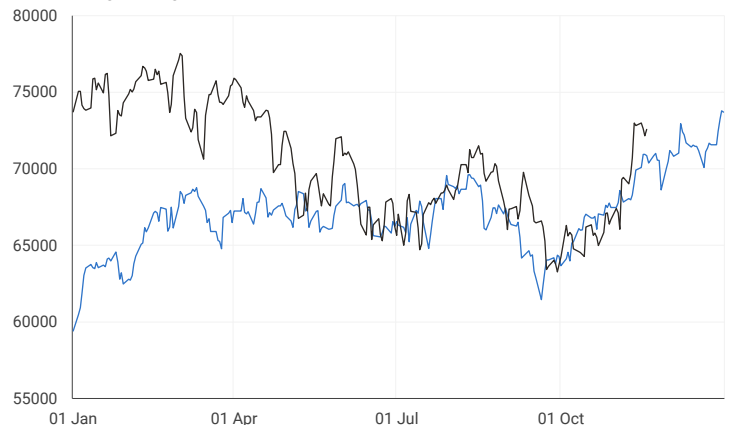

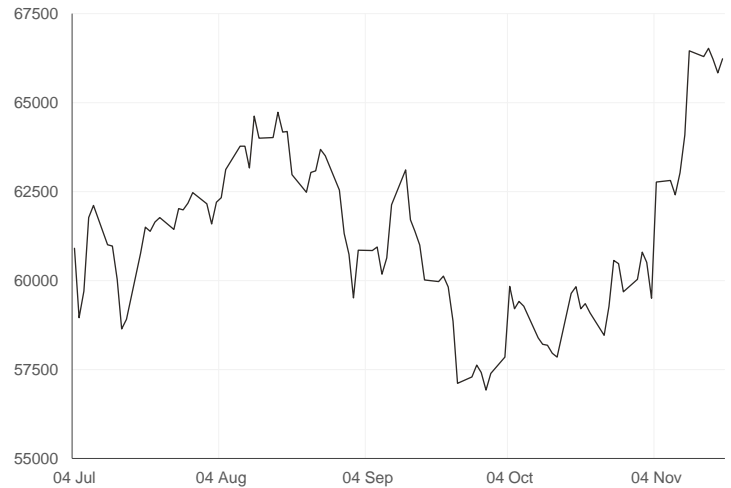

On the Johannesburg Stock Exchange, the Top-40 index closed 0.6% higher while the All-Share index closed up by 0.58% on Friday. On the data front, Consumer inflation slowed to 7.5% year on year in September, but it remains well above the 3%-6% target range. In sector news, the Alternative Energy sector gained 4.37% while the Construction and Materials was just below that, gaining 3.73% before the close of the session. Looking at companies, Karoo dropped by 4.26% on Friday, while Kap and Alphamin were the biggest winners, gaining 5.31% and 4.74% respectively.

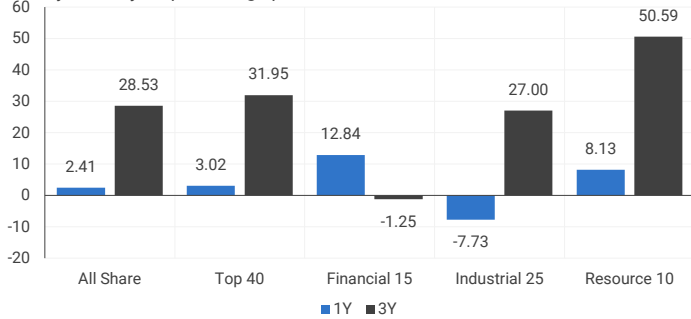
JSE TOP 40 INDEX

last 100 days



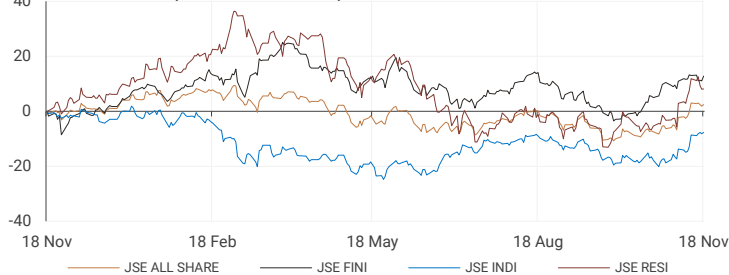

NOVUS HOLDINGS LIMITED – Unaudited Interim Results

Group revenue decreased by R45 million from R1 523 million to R1 478 million largely due to reduced print volumes across all product categories and the Novus Labels division's exit from a large customer contract in FY2022. Volumes were also reduced in comparison with the prior period. Operating profit decreased to R23,3 million (2021: operating profit of R90,3 million) and gross profit margin decreased to 16,9% (2021: 24,0%) due to paper price increases and energy surcharges levied by European paper suppliers, and higher logistical costs experienced throughout the period. The increased frequency of power outages created further operational challenges and required additional own power generation which increased operating costs by R12 million in the period. The Group's cash balances remained positive. No dividends were paid in the period to preserve cash for purposes of partially funding the acquisition of Pearson SA. Capital expenditure was modest at R16,0 million with spend directed toward maintenance of current plant and equipment with proceeds from asset sales in the period of R5,8 million.

SOUTHERN SUN LIMITED – Trading update

Revenue is expected to be between R1 505 million and R1 683 million higher, compared to the prior comparative period of R954 million. Excluding the once-off payment of R399 million received by the Group from Tsogo Sun Gaming Limited on implementation of the Separation Agreement on 30 September 2022 ("Separation Payment"), revenue is expected to be between R1 120 million and R1 270 million higher than the prior comparative period. EBITDAR is expected to be between R309 million and R337 million higher compared to the prior comparative period EBITDAR of R145 million. EBITDAR excludes the Separation Payment. Earnings per share ("EPS") is expected to be between 32.5 cents and 34.7 cents higher compared to the prior comparative period loss per share of 11.0 cents. Headline earnings per share ("HEPS") is expected to be between 33.2 cents and 35.2 cents higher, compared to the prior comparative period headline loss per share of 10.9 cents. HEPS includes the Separation Payment and Adjusted HEPS is expected to be between 11.9 cents and 13.7 cents higher, compared to the prior comparative period adjusted headline loss per share of 11.0 cents. Trading levels continue to recover due to Covid-19 restrictions having been lifted. The improvement in earnings is mainly driven by an increase in revenue across the business, due to a return to normalised travel patterns and conferencing as well as the lower base in the prior comparative period for the six months ended 30 September 2021, because of the third wave of Covid-19 infections and the violent protests and civil unrest experienced during June and July 2021 in Gauteng and KwaZulu-Natal and the resultant impact on travel.

2021 v 2022

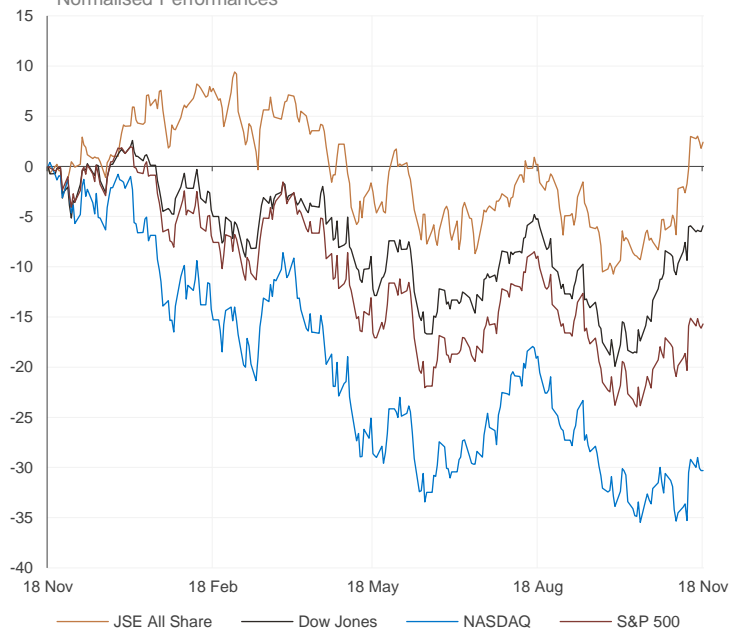

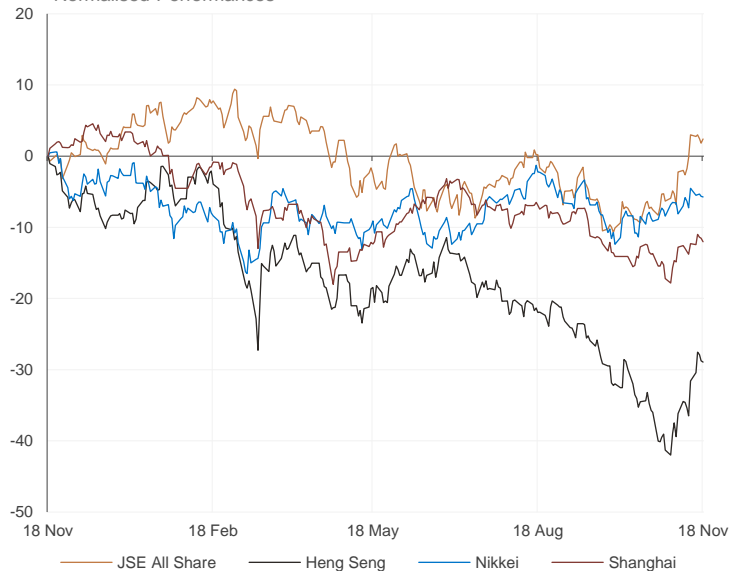
European Indices v JSE All Share Normalised Performances

SELECTED HEADLINES

European markets closed higher on Friday as investors continue to assess the trajectory of monetary policy after some tough statements from U.S. Federal Reserve officials. The Stoxx 600 closed up 1.1%, paring losses from the last two sessions to end the week higher than it began. Retail and auto stocks both added nearly 2% to lead gains as almost all sectors ended the session in positive territory. In company news, Austrian electricity provider Verbund remained the top climber among European stocks, up 8.2%. German lubricant manufacturer Fuchs posted the biggest decline, falling 4.6%.

SELECTED HEADLINES

US stocks ticked higher in afternoon trading Friday to end the day on an upbeat note as investors assessed tougher language from Federal Reserve speakers and pored over the latest earnings reports. Recent U.S. economic data shows inflation has finally peaked, the latest reading on the U.S. consumer price index showed a year-over-year increase of 7.7%, below a Dow Jones estimate of 7.9%. In company news, Foot Locker popped 15% in the premarket after earnings came in higher than expected and improving outlook. Ross Stores was up nearly 17% after its quarterly results came in above expectations on the top and bottom lines while Gap gained 8%.

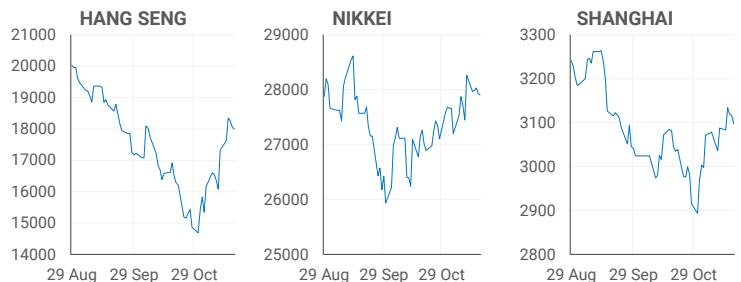

Shares in the Asia-Pacific traded mostly lower today as China's central bank kept its benchmark lending rates, or loan prime rates, on hold, in line with expectations. South Korea's exports for the first 20 days of November fell 16.7% on an annualized basis, with demand from China lagging. Imports also dropped 5.5% for the first 20 days of November, resulting in a slight improvement in the trade deficit of \$4.4 billion for the period, compared with a deficit of \$4.9 billion reported in October. Later this week, Baidu will report earnings and Singapore will release inflation data.

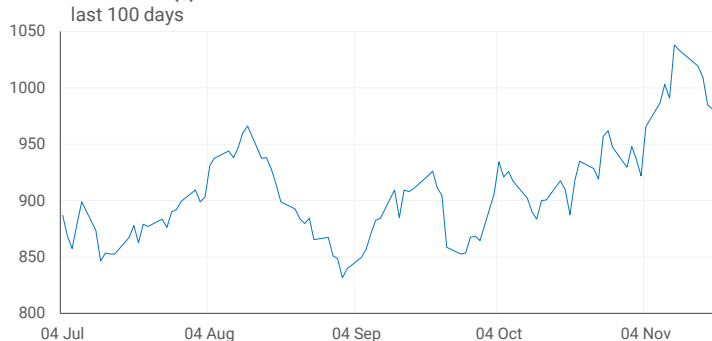

Gold prices stalled this morning, after marking its worst week in five, as traders awaited further cues on central banks' interest rates strategy. Meanwhile, oil prices hovered near two-month lows today as supply fears receded while concerns over China's fuel demand and rising interest rates weighed on prices. Tight crude supplies in Europe have eased as refiners have piled up stocks ahead of the Dec. 5 European Union embargo on Russian crude, putting pressure on physical crude markets across Europe, Africa and the United States.

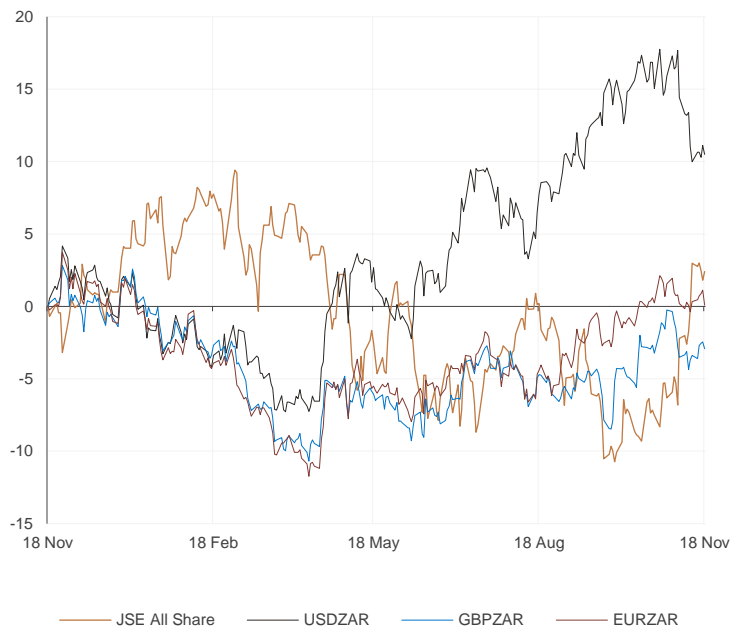

The rand strengthened on Friday, as investors awaited scheduled reviews of South Africa's sovereign credit ratings by S&P Global and Moody's later in the day. The rand traded at R17.29 against the dollar, 0.55% stronger than its previous close. The U.S. dollar started the week on the front foot, boosted by defensive buying as investors remained on edge following a spike in COVID-19 cases in some cities in China that prompted officials to tighten restrictions. The euro fell, while sterling last traded down this morning against the dollar. The Japanese yen also weakened against the dollar this morning.
