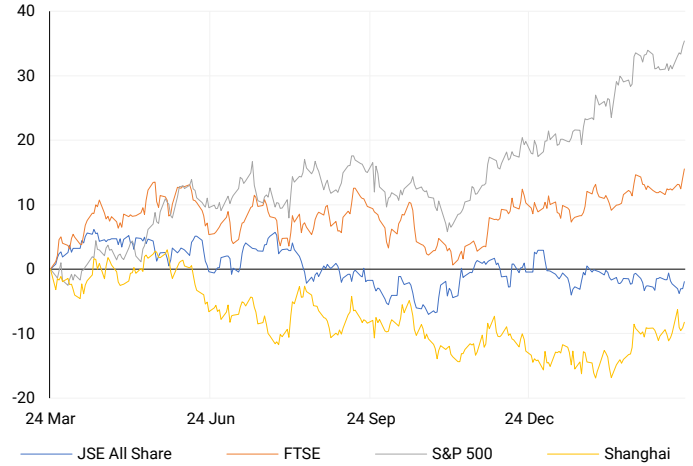

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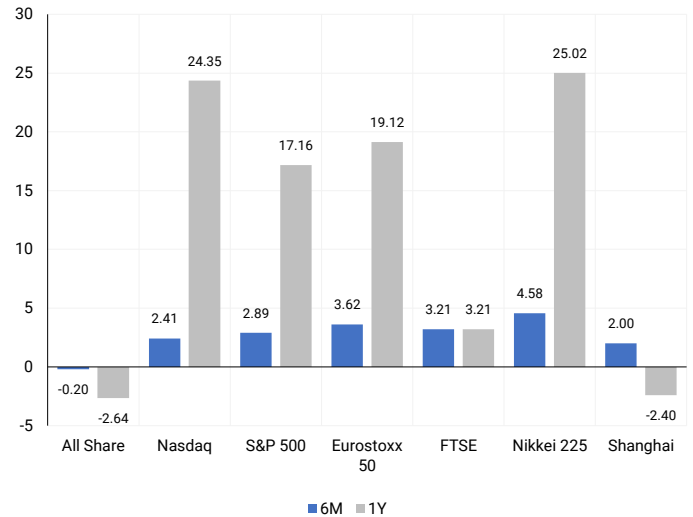

Normalised percentage performances - In rand terms



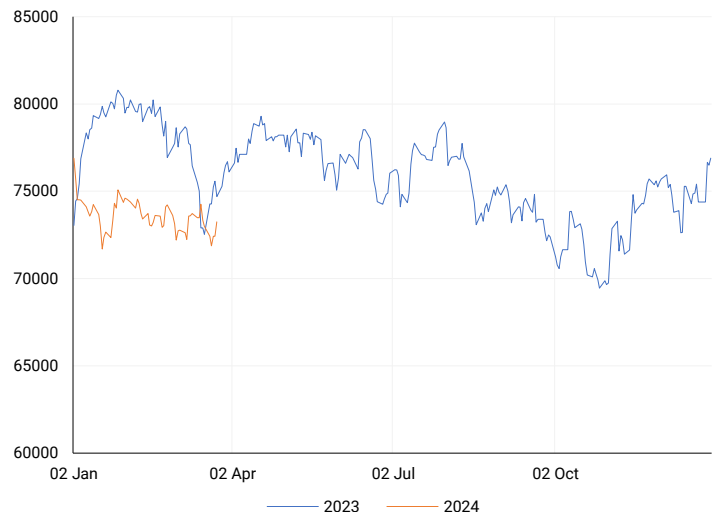

However, Gemfields Group Ltd cautioned investors about an expected annual loss due to a write-down in platinum group metals and the cancellation of an emerald auction.

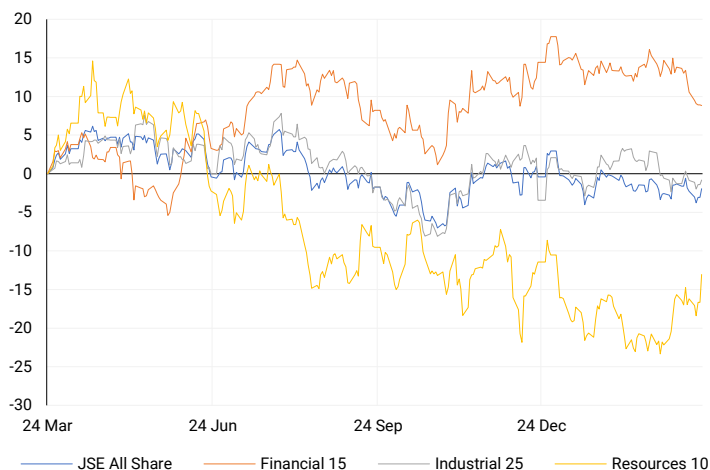
JSE TOP 40

BELL EQUIPMENT LIMITED – Further Trading Statement

Shareholders are reminded of the trading statement released on November 7, 2023, indicating that the Company anticipated reporting significant growth in earnings per share and headline earnings per share for the year ending December 31, 2023, compared to the previous year. Specifically, an increase of 272 cents per share or 57% for earnings per share and 277 cents per share or 59% for headline earnings per share was projected. However, the latest advice to shareholders reveals even more promising figures, with earnings per share and headline earnings per share expected to range between 780 cents and 820 cents per share. This represents a substantial increase of between 302 cents or 63% and 342 cents or 72% per share for earnings per share, and between 307 cents or 65% and 347 cents or 73% per share for headline earnings per share, compared to the previous year's figures. The remarkable uptick in earnings is primarily attributed to favourable market conditions.

GEMFIELDS GROUP LIMITED – Trading Statement

In 2023, Gemfields' key operating assets, Kagem and MRM, generated revenues of USD 89.9 million and USD 151.4 million, respectively, showing a decline from the previous year's figures of USD 148.6 million for Kagem and USD 166.7 million for MRM. Despite one less high-quality emerald auction, the total auction revenues for the year marked the second-highest in the Group's history, indicating sustained demand for colored gemstones. However, Fabergé experienced a decrease in revenues to USD 15.7 million compared to USD 17.6 million in 2022 due to a softer luxury market. A review of Gemfields' shareholding in Sedibelo Resources Limited led to a significant fair value write-down of USD 28.0 million to USD 4.0 million, reflecting reduced valuations for comparable PGM companies and Sedibelo's weakened financial performance. Gemfields expects a net loss after tax of USD 2.8 million for 2023, primarily driven by the Sedibelo write-down and the absence of a higher-quality emerald auction. Loss per share is anticipated to be USDc 0.8, while headline loss per share, including Sedibelo's fair value loss, is expected to be USDc 0.9. Adjusted headline earnings per share, excluding Sedibelo's fair value loss, are projected to be USDc 1.5.

2023 vs 2024 to date

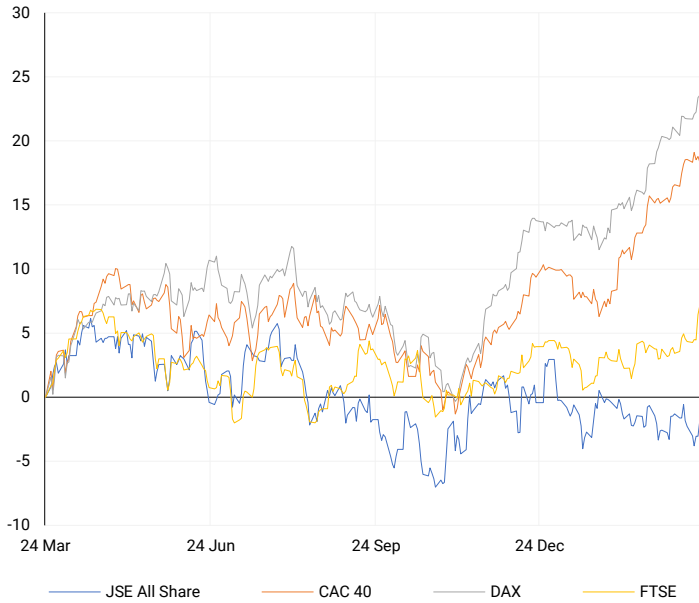

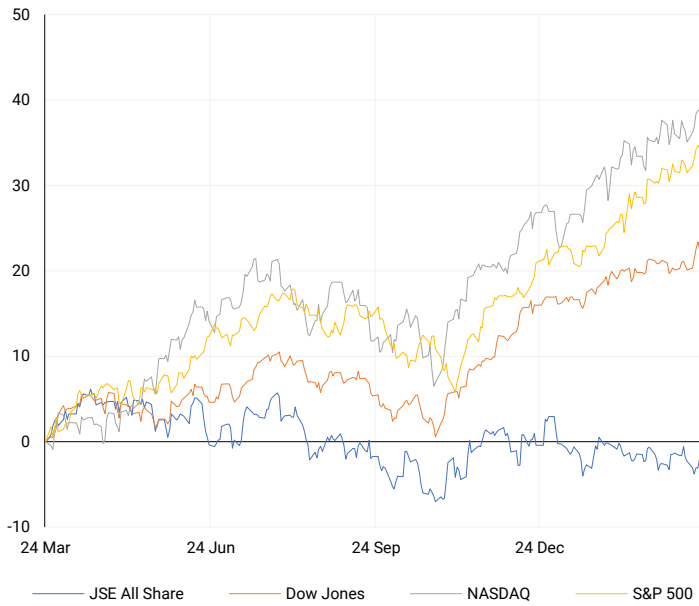

Normalised percentage performances



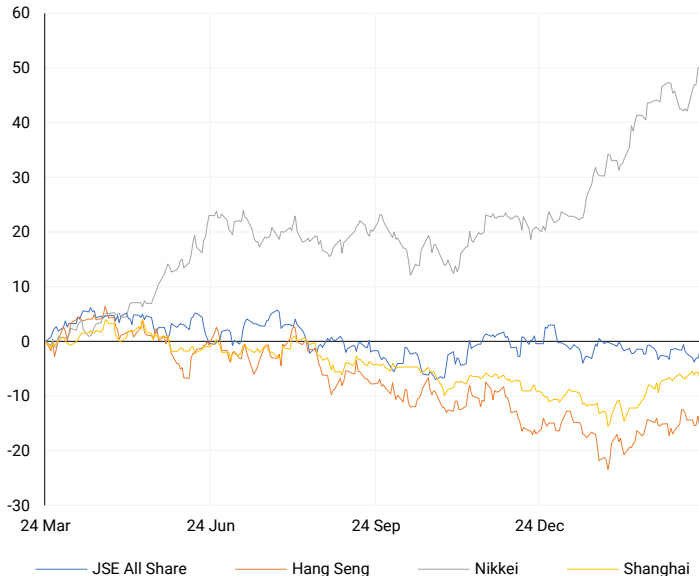

Normalised percentage performances



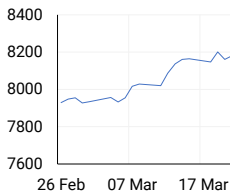

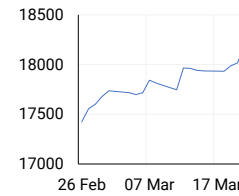
European markets closed slightly higher on Friday following a record-breaking session, spurred by recent interest rate decisions. The Swiss National Bank surprised markets by reducing its main policy rate, making Switzerland the first major economy to cut rates, reflecting policymakers' confidence in curbing inflation. The Bank of England maintained rates but hinted at potential cuts amid faster-than-expected inflation declines. Norway's central bank opted to keep its benchmark rate steady, projecting a future rate cut later in the year. The pan-European Stoxx 600 ended marginally higher, with technology and travel sectors experiencing losses, down 0.7% and 1.17%, respectively.

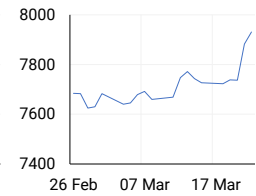

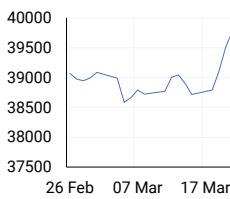

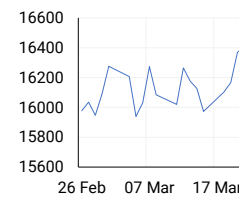
The US market is set for its fifth straight month of gains, with major U.S. stock indices hitting new record highs last week. These gains were driven by the Federal Reserve's recent comments maintaining expectations of rate cuts this year and ongoing investor excitement for tech stocks amid an AI-driven surge. Investor sentiment remains upbeat, according to the latest American Association of Individual Investors Sentiment Survey. However, concerns linger about a potential market overextension and prolonged high interest rates.

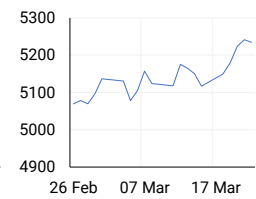

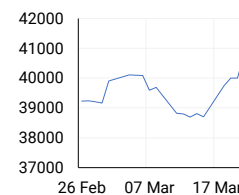
Asian shares were hesitant this morning as investors expressed concerns about upcoming U.S. inflation data potentially impacting expectations for lower interest rates. The risk of currency intervention from Japan temporarily halted the yen's decline. China's central bank also boosted the yuan, leading to a broader decrease in the dollar. With Japan's stock market hitting consecutive record highs and market closures on Friday for several centres, including Hong Kong, Asian investors may lean towards caution ahead of upcoming economic indicators.

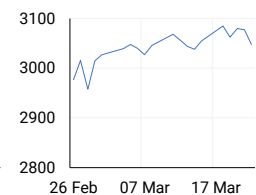

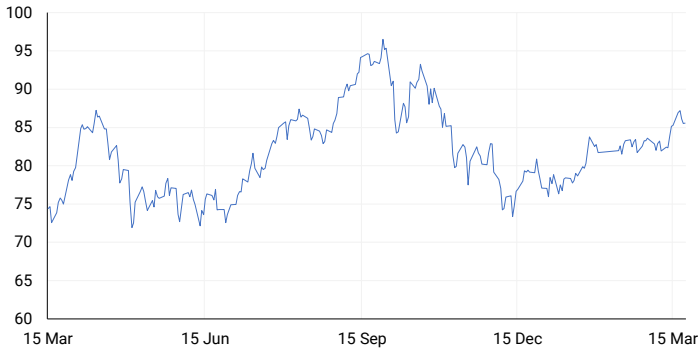
SELECTED ITEMS

Gold prices remained stable this morning as investors awaited U.S. inflation data later in the week to gauge its potential impact on the Federal Reserve's projected three rate cuts for this year. Meanwhile, oil prices surged in early Asian trading due to concerns about tighter global supply amid escalating conflicts in the Middle East and between Russia and Ukraine. Additionally, a decline in the U.S. rig count added further upward pressure on oil prices.

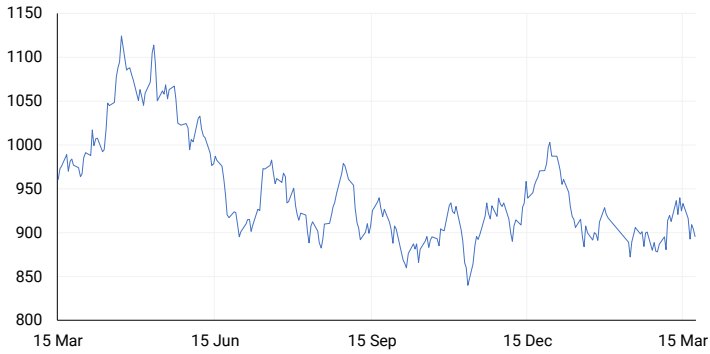

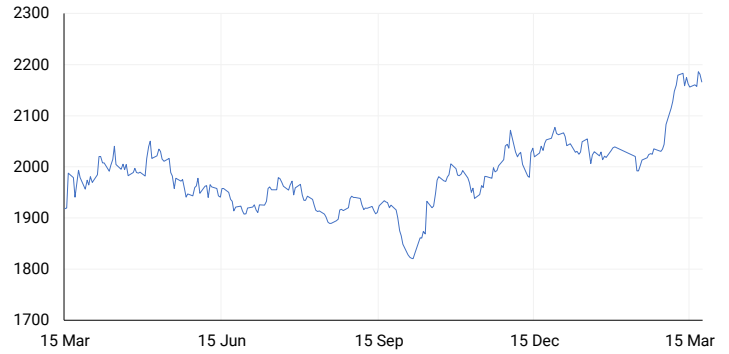

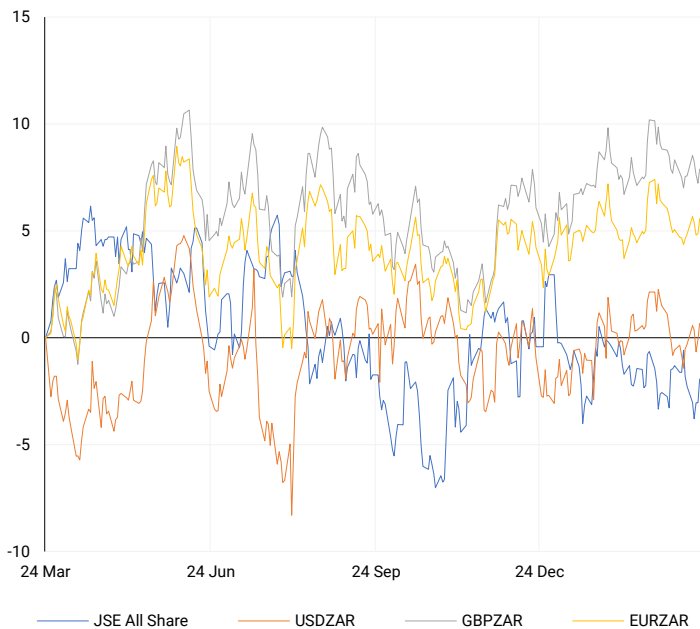

SELECTED ITEMS

On Friday, South Africa's rand depreciated alongside other emerging market currencies, as the U.S. dollar strengthened amid global risk sentiment. This morning, the dollar maintained its strength, keeping the yen close to a multi-decade low. However, the potential for currency intervention by Japanese authorities restrained the dollar from advancing further. Japan's leading currency diplomat remarked that the yen's current weakness doesn't accurately represent its fundamentals. This statement aligns with recent warnings from government officials about the yen's declining value.
