





The JSE's Top 40 index increased by 0.47%, closing at 79,635.5 points, while the All Share index rose 0.32% to finish at 87,474.5 points on Friday. In international news, the White House revealed that U.S. President Donald Trump signed an executive order reducing financial aid to South Africa due to concerns over its land policies and legal actions against Israel at the International Court of Justice. U.S. assistance to South Africa in 2023 amounted to nearly \$440 million. South Africa's foreign ministry criticized the decision, citing the country's history of injustice. Additionally, regional leaders at a summit in Eastern and Southern Africa called for direct negotiations to address escalating tensions in Eastern Congo, which include engagement with Rwanda-backed rebel groups.

RCL FOODS Limited – Strong Earnings Growth in Interim Results

RCL FOODS expects headline earnings per share (HEPS) for the six months ended December 2024 to increase between 31.2% and 38.6%, reaching between 106.0 cents and 112.0 cents, compared to 80.8 cents in the prior period. Earnings per share (EPS) is anticipated to rise between 9.3% and 15.2%, reflecting non-cash gains from the unbundling of Rainbow and prior-year asset disposals. HEPS from continuing operations is projected to grow between 34.5% and 42.1%, driven by gains in Groceries and Baking, as well as a partial recovery in Sugar from industry levy adjustments. Despite volume pressures, strategic cost management, sales mix optimization, and lower input costs contributed to the improved performance. Full results will be released on 3 March 2025.



EUROPEAN MARKET SUMMARY

SELECTED ITEMS

European equities ended lower on Friday, with trade war fears impacting investor sentiment. The STOXX 600 index dropped 0.4%, while automakers declined by 1.6%, exacerbated by Porsche's weak profit margin outlook. The European Central Bank provided guidance on the euro area's neutral deposit rate, estimating it to be between 1.75% and 2.25%. German exports rose by 2.9% in December, defying expectations of a decline, though industrial output fell by 2.4%, highlighting concerns over the eurozone's largest economy. For 2024, German exports decreased by 1.0% due to weak demand from China. In the UK, house prices climbed 0.7% in January, surpassing expectations as buyers rushed to finalize transactions ahead of April's tax changes.

AMERICAN MARKET SUMMARY

SELECTED ITEMS

U.S. stocks closed lower on Friday after President Donald Trump announced plans for reciprocal tariffs on multiple countries, adding to concerns sparked by weaker-than-expected jobs data and a sharp decline in consumer sentiment. Consumer inflation expectations surged to 4.3%, the highest since November 2023, while job growth slowed in January, raising expectations that the Federal Reserve may delay rate cuts until at least June. A final employment revision showed 598,000 fewer jobs were created in the 12 months ending last March than previously estimated, though the downward adjustment was smaller than earlier projections. Market breadth was weak, with declining issues outpacing advancers by nearly 2.8-to-1 on the NYSE and 2.5-to-1 on the Nasdaq.




ASIAN MARKET SUMMARY

SELECTED ITEMS

Asia-Pacific markets opened with mixed performance, following weaker U.S. stock futures as investors remained cautious ahead of key economic releases. In China, consumer inflation rose for the first time since August 2024, with the CPI increasing by 0.7% month-on-month and 0.5% annually in January, surpassing expectations. However, producer prices continued to decline, with the PPI falling 2.3% year-on-year, a steeper drop than anticipated. Indian markets remained under pressure after the Reserve Bank of India delivered its first interest rate cut in five years, adding to investor uncertainty.





CURRENCY PAIRS vs JSE ALL SHARE Normalised percentage performances




COMMODITIES MARKET SUMMARY

SELECTED ITEMS

Gold prices remained firm near record highs as investors turned to safe-haven assets following U.S. President Donald Trump's announcement of new tariffs, heightening fears of a global trade war. Meanwhile, oil prices edged higher despite concerns that the planned 25% tariffs on steel and aluminum imports could dampen economic growth and energy demand. Australia's trade minister emphasized the importance of the country's steel and aluminum exports to U.S. jobs and defense ties as Canberra seeks an exemption from the new duties.






CURRENCY MARKET SUMMARY

SELECTED ITEMS

The South African rand strengthened on Friday following President Cyril Ramaphosa's announcement of a second wave of economic reforms aimed at stimulating growth. Meanwhile, the pound rebounded after losses triggered by the Bank of England's rate cut and downgraded growth forecast. The U.S. dollar firmed as markets reacted to President Donald Trump's plans to impose 25% tariffs on all steel and aluminum imports, putting pressure on the euro and commodity-linked currencies such as the Australian and New Zeeland dollars.
