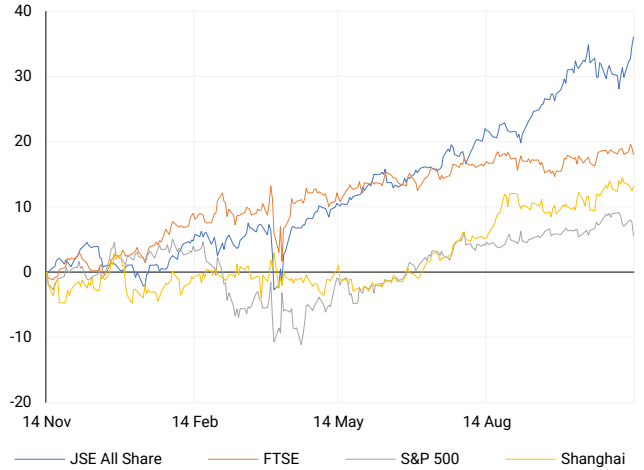

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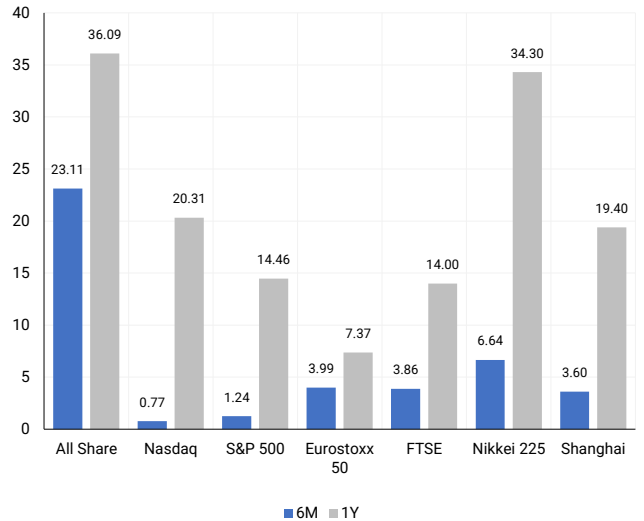

Local equities advanced, with the Top 40 gaining 1.05% as investors reacted favourably to the Medium-Term Budget Policy Statement, which outlined a third straight primary surplus and reinforced South Africa's fiscal consolidation path under Finance Minister Enoch Godongwana. However, risks remain due to softer revenue trends, elevated refinancing obligations and vulnerability to commodity swings. Corporate activity picked up ahead of Cell C's proposed JSE debut, targeting up to R6.5 billion. Regulators also announced significant concessions from global tech platforms, while confirmation that China's President Xi will miss the G20 dampened diplomatic expectations.

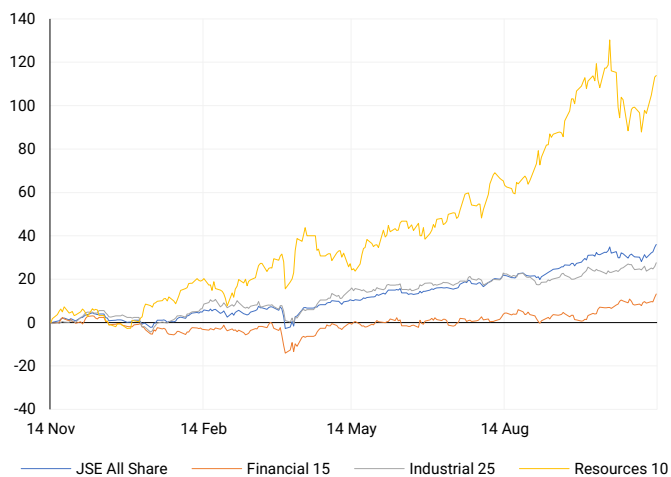
JSE ALL SHARE

Sanlam – Strong Momentum Despite Macro Headwinds

Sanlam delivered a resilient nine-month performance to 30 September 2025, with disciplined execution driving solid growth across key metrics. Net results from financial services rose 17% (19% normalised), while net operational earnings increased 14% (16% normalised). New business volumes expanded 11%, supported by a 1% improvement in life insurance sales and a stable 2.25% VNB margin. Regulatory and economic solvency ratios remained firm at 167% and 184%. Despite geopolitical and tariff pressures, improving energy conditions and easing inflation continue to support a gradual recovery in household income.

Brimstone Investment – NAV Hit by Softer Portfolio Valuations

Brimstone posted a 22.8% drop in intrinsic NAV to R2.07 billion for the quarter to 30 September 2025, as weaker valuations across several core holdings weighed on performance. Intrinsic NAV per share declined to 860 cents, with ordinary and 'N' shares trading at wide discounts of 50.5% and 47.5%, respectively. Lower valuations in Oceana, Phuthuma Nathi and MTN Zakhele Futhi were partly offset by gains in FPG Property Fund, Aon Re Africa and FPG Investments. While diversified, the portfolio's steep discounts reflect persistent caution in the South African investment environment.

Brait – Operational Progress Underpins Stable Interim Results

Brait delivered steady interim earnings for the six months to 30 September 2025, supported by strong operational performance across its major holdings. Virgin Active posted robust revenue momentum and a 45% lift in LTM EBITDA, driven by estate refurbishments and improved member engagement. Premier delivered another strong period, with revenue up 6% and EBITDA up 14% amid continued strength in the MillBake division and further de-gearing. New Look increased profitability despite a challenging UK retail backdrop. Brait's NAV per share rose 5% to R3.21, supported by R710 million in liquidity and full covenant compliance.

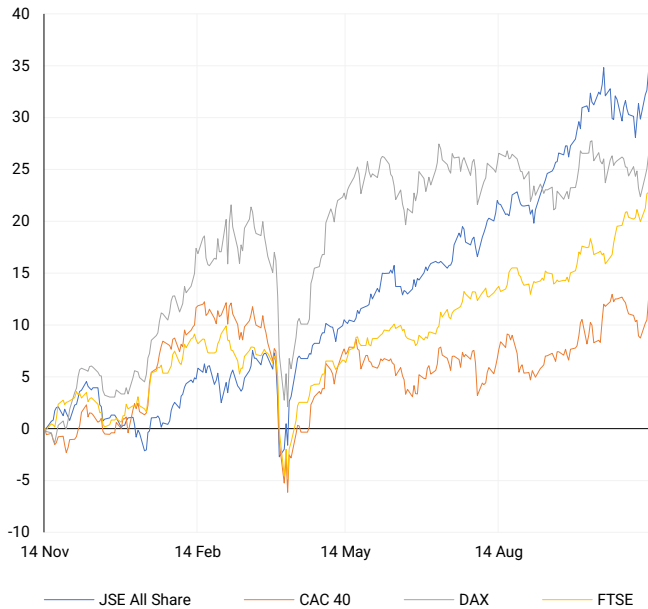
SOUTH AFRICAN 10-YEAR

2024 vs 2025 to date



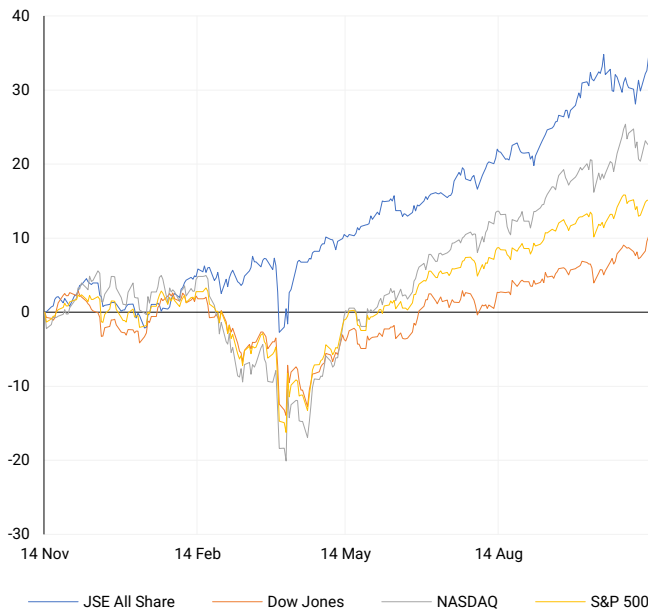

Normalised percentage performances



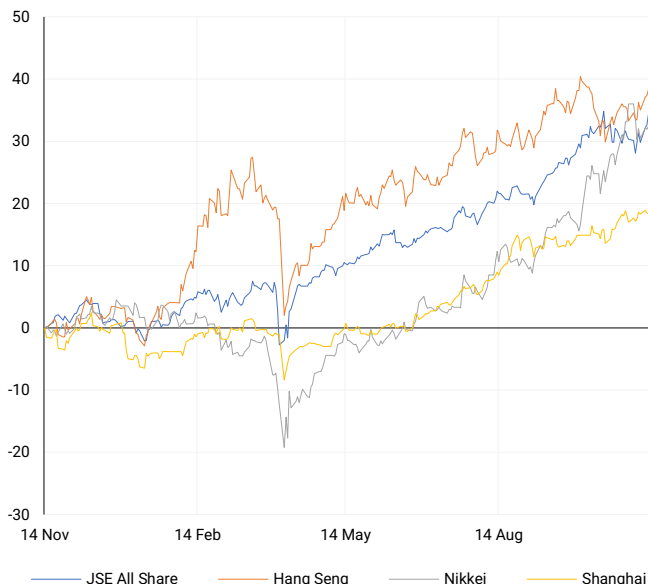

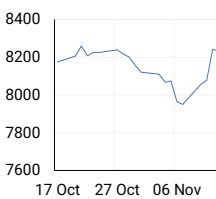

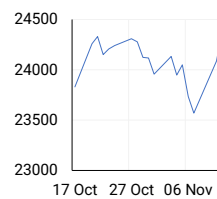
European bourses finished lower, with the STOXX 600 down 0.6% as attention shifted to upcoming US economic data following the resolution of Washington's record shutdown. Softer sentiment, coupled with weaker-than-expected earnings from Siemens, weighed on the DAX and FTSE 100. The UK's decision to extend Megan Greene's term on the Bank of England's MPC provides policy continuity as inflation moderation remains the priority. Eurozone industrial output rose only marginally in September, missing forecasts, while UK housing demand eased ahead of potential tax measures in the late-November budget.

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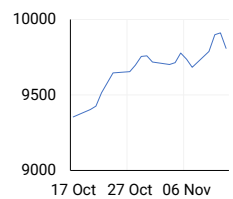

SELECTED ITEMS

US equities suffered their sharpest daily pullback in over a month, driven by heavy selling in Nvidia and other AI leaders as markets dialed back expectations of a December rate cut. Conflicting labour indicators—ranging from falling retail job postings to private-sector job losses—added to uncertainty. With the 43-day government shutdown now over, delayed data releases should resume, though recent Fed commentary emphasised persistent inflation risks. Futures currently price in roughly a 47% chance of a 25bp cut in December, down markedly from levels seen a week earlier.

ASIAN MARKET SUMMARY

SELECTED ITEMS

Asia-Pacific indices mirrored Wall Street's weakness, with tech counters under pressure amid fading confidence in near-term Fed easing. China's October numbers highlighted slowing momentum, with factory output and retail sales expanding at their weakest pace in more than a year. Property-sector strains continued, as new-home prices recorded their largest monthly fall in twelve months. The data reinforced the view that China may need stronger policy intervention to stabilise demand as both domestic sentiment and external markets remain fragile. Regional investors stayed cautious in response to the deteriorating backdrop.

SELECTED ITEMS

Gold edged higher and is poised for a weekly advance, supported by a softer US dollar despite ongoing hawkishness from Federal Reserve speakers. Oil benchmarks climbed more than 2% following a Ukrainian drone strike on infrastructure in Russia's Novorossiysk port, heightening supply concerns. New US sanctions on Rosneft and Lukoil are slowing tanker activity, with JPMorgan estimating around 1.4 million bpd of Russian crude now stored offshore. Meanwhile, US crude inventories jumped by 6.4 million barrels—well above expectations—adding another layer of volatility to energy markets.

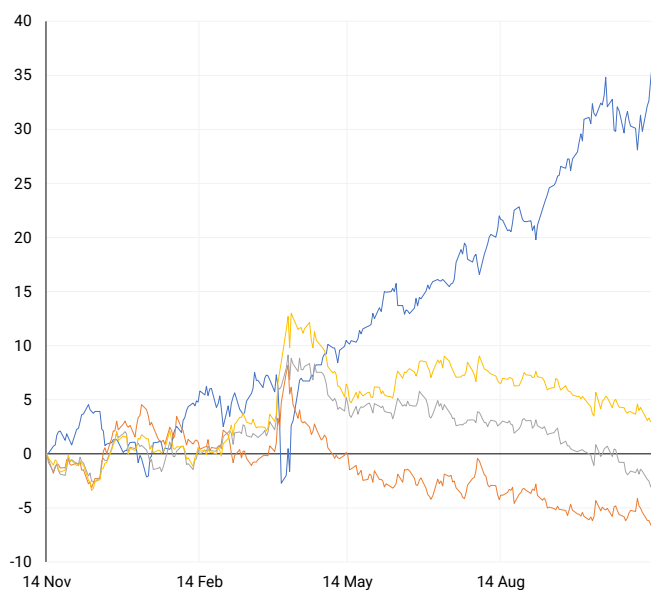
SELECTED ITEMS

The rand extended its rally, strengthening through the R17/\$ level for the first time since early 2023 as investors rewarded the government's reaffirmed fiscal discipline. Broader currency moves were shaped by continued dollar softness, driven by market caution and delayed US data releases after the prolonged shutdown. Heightened volatility in US bonds and equities further discouraged risk-taking, prompting traders to reassess the likelihood of a December rate cut. With sentiment turning against the dollar, the greenback remains on course for a weekly decline.
