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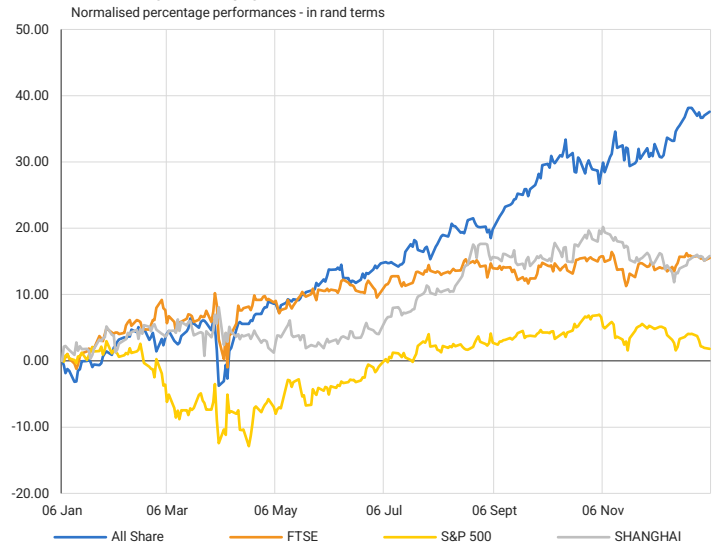

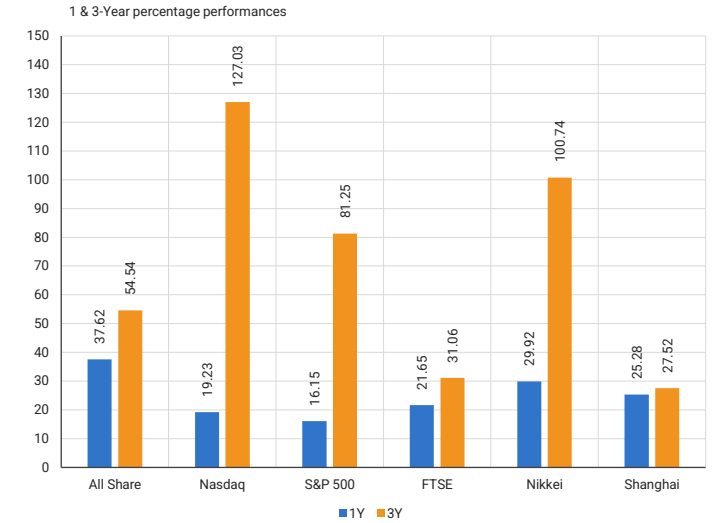

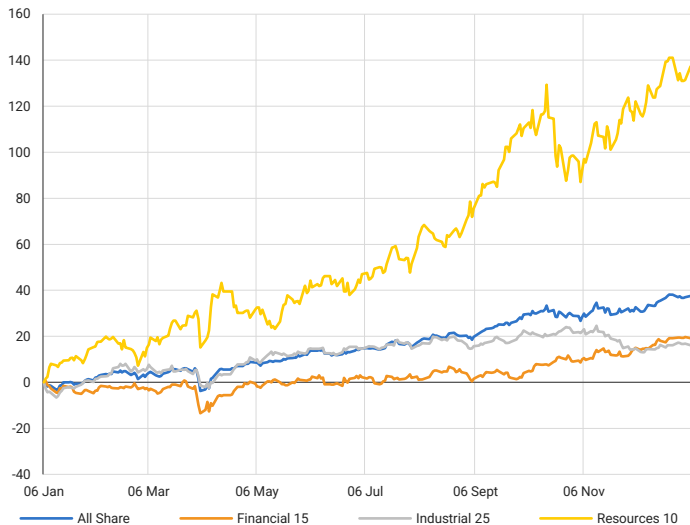
The JSE Top 40 Index rose 0.51% to 108,781.31 points, while the All Share Index gained 0.42% to 116,582.66 points. Resources outperformed, with the Resources 10 Index up 2.54%, offsetting declines of 0.49% and 0.57% in the Financial 15 and Industrial 25 indices respectively. ASP Isotopes led the day's gainers, advancing 11.83%, alongside broad strength across mining counters. Separately, Nersa has proposed recovering an additional R76 billion from consumers to compensate Eskom for past regulatory errors, exceeding the previously contested R54 billion settlement.

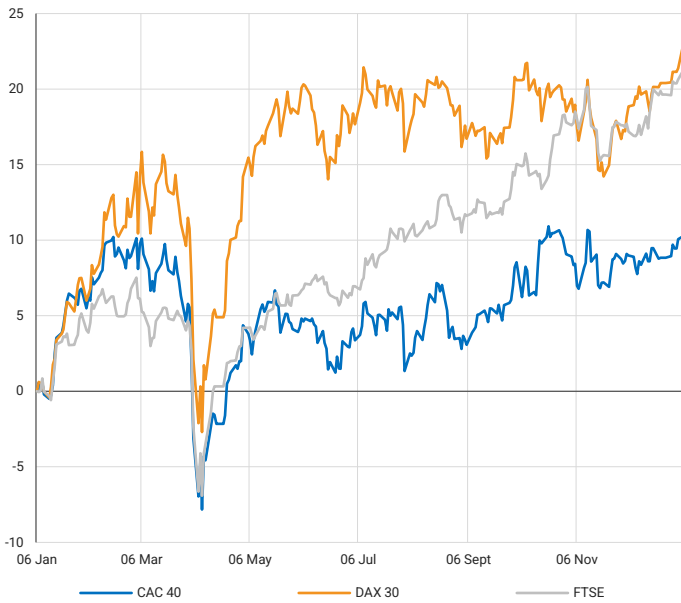

## EUROPEAN MARKET SUMMARY

### SELECTED HEADLINES AND THEMES

The STOXX 600 closed above the 600 level for the first time at 601.76 (+0.9%), supported by strong gains in defence stocks after US strikes on Venezuela heightened geopolitical risk. The defence index rose 4.1%, with Rheinmetall up 9.3%. Germany's DAX also reached a record high. Investors now turn attention to central bank policy guidance and macroeconomic indicators, while stronger-than-expected UK consumer borrowing pointed to resilient household demand ahead of the forthcoming Budget.

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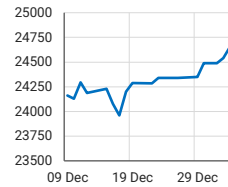

Last 20 Sessions



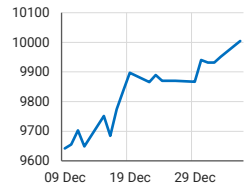
#### DAX 30

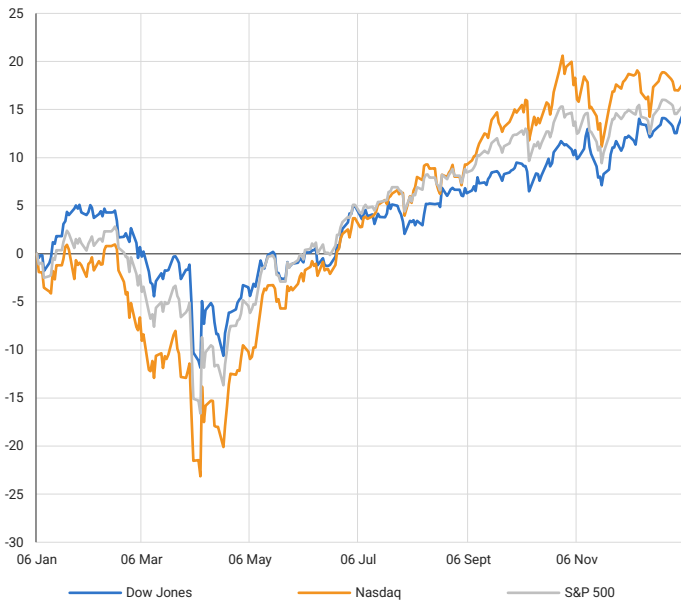

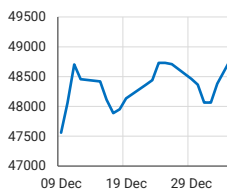
### SELECTED HEADLINES AND THEMES

US equities closed higher, with the Dow Jones Industrial Average reaching a fresh record as financial and defence stocks outperformed. Energy counters also advanced after the US capture of Venezuelan President Nicolas Maduro raised expectations of renewed access to Venezuelan oil reserves. Trading volumes were elevated at over 19 billion shares. The S&P 500 Financials Index gained 2.2% ahead of results, with sector earnings expected to rise 6.7% year on year. Attention now turns to the upcoming nonfarm payrolls data for policy direction.

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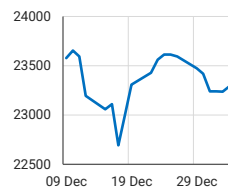

Last 20 Sessions



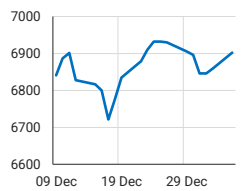
#### NASDAQ

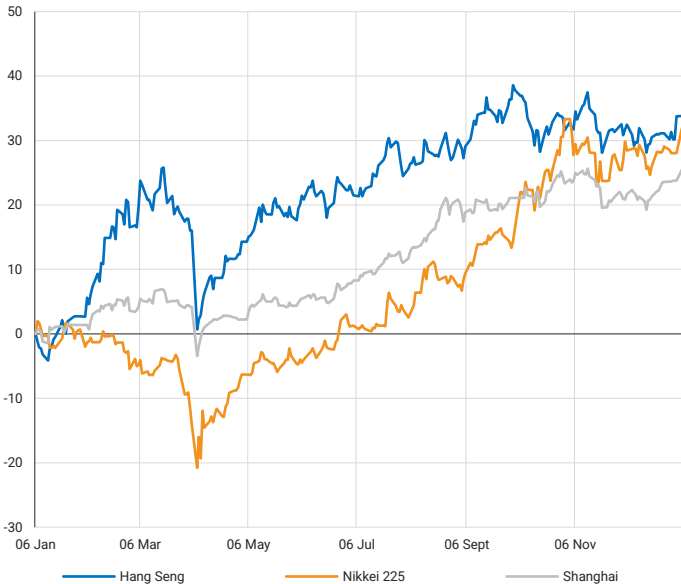

## ASIAN MARKET SUMMARY

### SELECTED HEADLINES AND THEMES

Asian markets traded mixed, although defence stocks extended gains for a second session as investors assessed geopolitical developments following the US capture of Venezuela's ousted leader, Nicolas Maduro. Kawasaki Heavy Industries and IHI rose more than 3%, while Korea Aerospace gained as much as 11%. China's NFRA asked major lenders to review Venezuela-related credit exposure. Elsewhere, Indonesia reported a narrower-than-expected November trade surplus, while Vietnam's economy grew 8% in 2025 on resilient US-bound exports despite tariff headwinds.

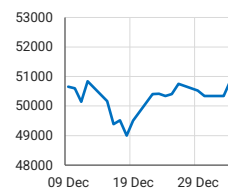

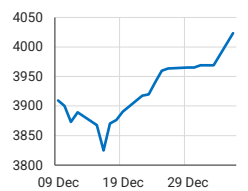

**SELECTED HEADLINES AND THEMES**

Oil prices eased as traders priced in the prospect of higher Venezuelan production following the US capture of Nicolas Maduro, increasing the likelihood of sanctions relief. This reinforces expectations of ample global supply and softer demand into 2026. Gold extended gains to a one-week high as dovish Federal Reserve comments boosted rate-cut expectations, while geopolitical tensions supported safe-haven demand. Markets now look to US policy signals and clarity on Venezuelan supply normalisation.

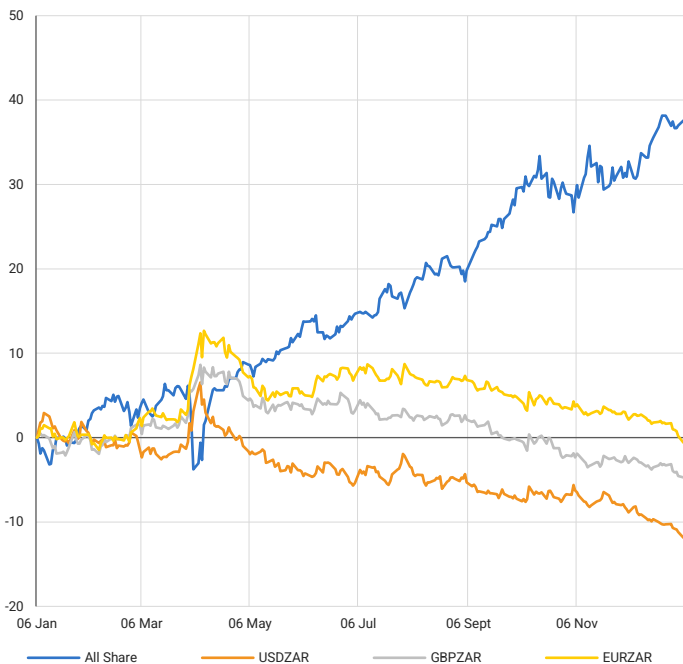

**SELECTED HEADLINES AND THEMES**

The South African rand was little changed as investors assessed the geopolitical implications of US military action in Venezuela, which supported safe-haven demand. South Africa has called for an urgent UN Security Council session in response. The US dollar traded near a two-week high, with the dollar index at 98.36, as earlier volatility eased and dovish Federal Reserve remarks supported risk appetite. However, weaker US manufacturing data and rising expectations of policy easing tempered further dollar strength.
