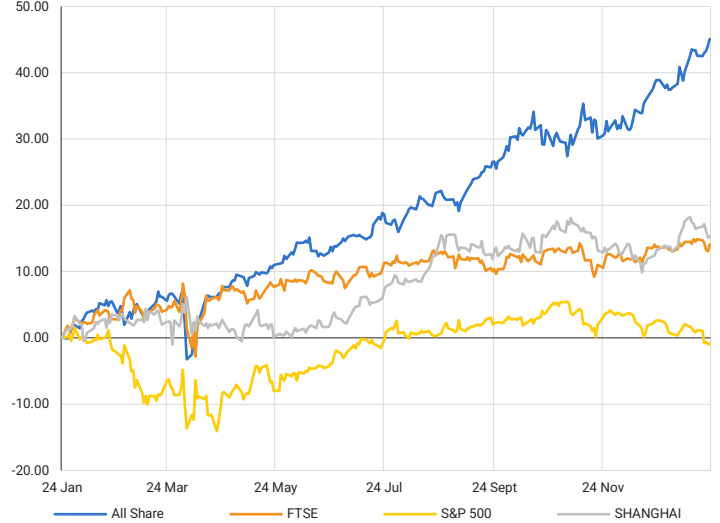

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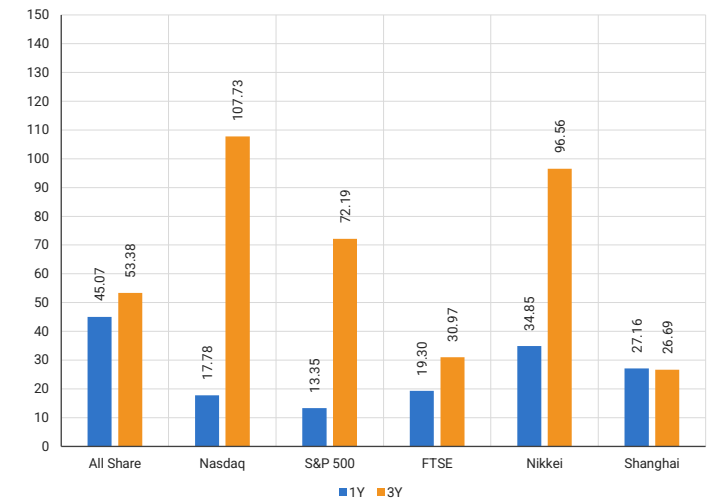

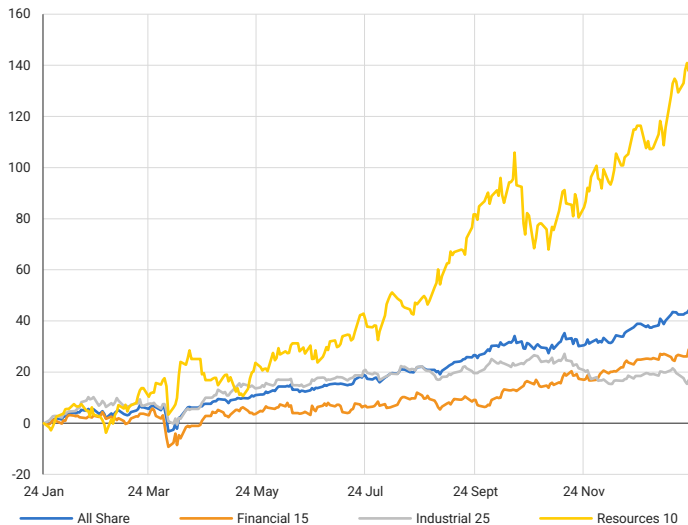
South African equities closed firmer, with the All Share Index rising 0.64% to 122,281.28 points and the Top 40 advancing 0.76% to 114,357.72. Gains in Resources, up 3.41%, more than offset weakness in Financials and Industrials. Corporate attention centred on Nissan Motor, which confirmed plans to sell its Rosslyn manufacturing assets to the local unit of Chery Automobile, subject to regulatory approval. The disposal forms part of Nissan's global restructuring, while Chery has previously flagged multiple strategic options to expand its South African manufacturing footprint.

#### Valterra Platinum – Earnings Surge on Pricing and Cost Discipline

Valterra Platinum flagged a materially stronger FY25 earnings outcome, with headline earnings and HEPS expected to increase by 85%–105% year on year. Performance was driven by a 26% stronger PGM dollar basket price and R5 billion in operational cost reductions, more than offsetting inflation, demerger-related costs and non-recurring asset write-offs. Basic earnings are forecast to rise 105%–125%, despite lower sales volumes linked to prior-period work-in-progress drawdowns and flooding at Amandelbult, partially mitigated by insurance proceeds.

#### Reinet Investments S.C.A. – NAV Softens, Strategic Disposal in Focus

Reinet Investments reported a modest decline in net asset value during the December 2025 quarter, with NAV down 1.0% quarter on quarter to EUR 6.6 billion and NAV per share easing to EUR 36.24. Long-term performance remains solid, reflecting an 8.4% compound annual growth rate in euro terms since 2009, including dividends. The group funded EUR 15 million of commitments during the quarter, while the agreed sale of Pension Insurance Corporation Group to Athora, expected to close in 2026, remains a key near-term catalyst.

#### Mr Price Group – NKD Transaction Progresses, Investor Update Scheduled

Mr Price Group confirmed continued progress on its acquisition of NKD Group GmbH, with conditions precedent advancing largely as planned. The primary outstanding approval relates to the European Commission's Foreign Subsidies Regulation, with the formal review period now underway and no material delays anticipated. Management also announced an investor presentation scheduled for 17 March 2026 in Cape Town, where it will outline NKD's strategic rationale, growth prospects and expected contribution, providing greater clarity on the transaction's medium-term implications.

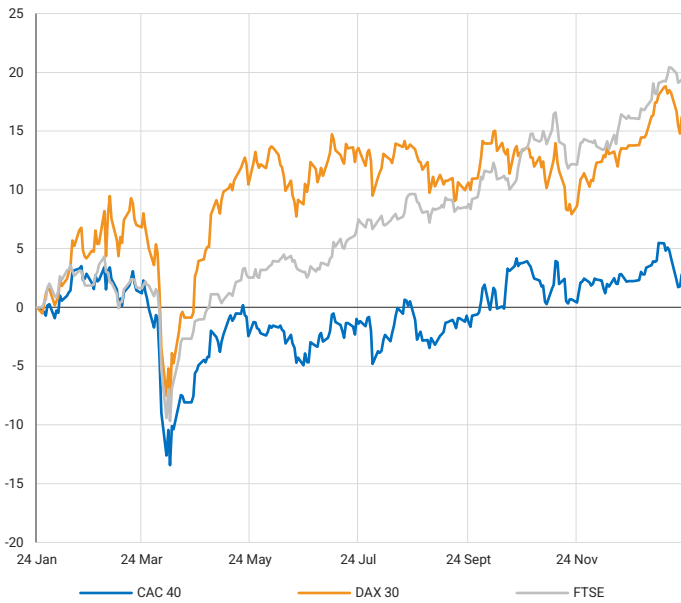

## EUROPEAN MARKET SUMMARY

### SELECTED HEADLINES AND THEMES

European equities ended lower and posted weekly declines as investors remained cautious amid heightened geopolitical uncertainty linked to tensions with the United States. The STOXX 600 snapped a five-week winning streak, with insurance stocks under pressure alongside a sell-off in longer-dated bonds. Strength in energy and mining stocks helped limit broader losses, reflecting elevated commodity prices and risk aversion. On the corporate front, Ericsson rallied strongly after a fourth-quarter earnings beat and the announcement of a share buyback, while Adidas and Puma weakened following broker downgrades and valuation concerns.

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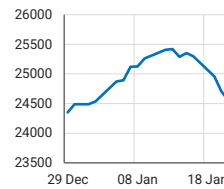

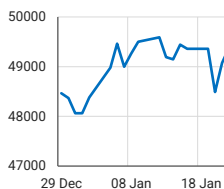
### SELECTED HEADLINES AND THEMES

US markets finished mixed after a volatile week, with the Dow Jones easing and the S&P 500 largely unchanged. Sentiment was weighed down by a sharp sell-off in Intel, which issued weaker-than-expected guidance amid difficulties meeting demand for AI-related server chips. Despite renewed geopolitical noise around potential tariffs, investors remain broadly constructive on the resilience of the US economy. Mega-cap technology stocks rebounded on continued AI optimism, while Nvidia gained following reports of potential renewed demand from major Chinese technology groups.

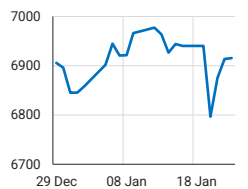

## ASIAN MARKET SUMMARY

### SELECTED HEADLINES AND THEMES

Asia-Pacific markets traded mixed as investors assessed ongoing geopolitical risks and regional data. China reported a year-on-year decline in foreign direct investment during 2025, underscoring persistent structural and confidence challenges, although inflows from select European and Middle Eastern countries improved. In corporate developments, Chinese energy drink producer Eastroc Beverage is pursuing a sizeable Hong Kong listing to fund capacity expansion, while South Korea's S-Oil reported a sharp increase in quarterly operating profit and guided to resilient refining margins supported by supply disruptions and steady demand.

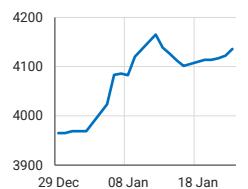

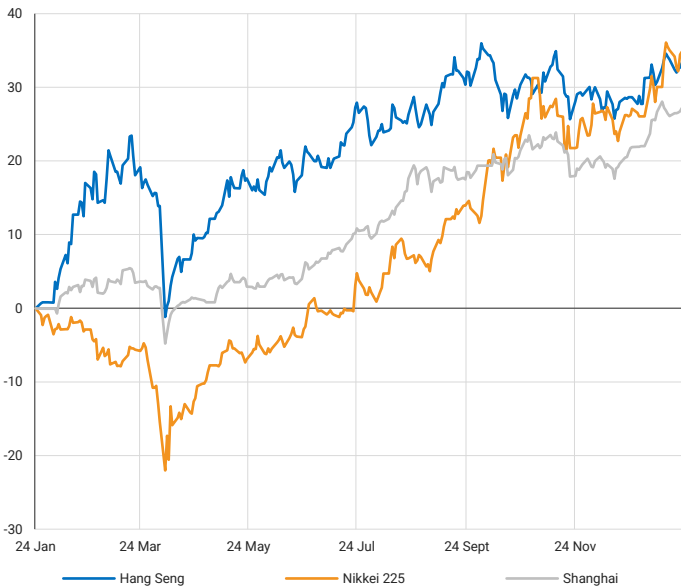

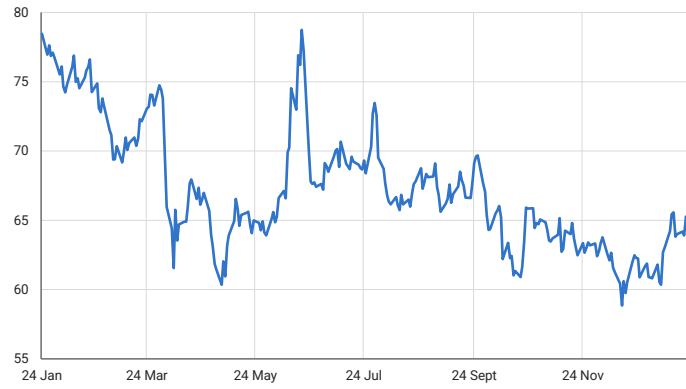
## COMMODITIES MARKET SUMMARY

### SELECTED HEADLINES AND THEMES

Oil prices stabilised after recent gains as supply disruptions in the United States and elevated Middle East tensions continued to underpin the market. Weather-related production losses and geopolitical risk premia offset concerns around demand momentum. Kazakhstan's Caspian Pipeline Consortium returned to full capacity following maintenance, easing some supply-side pressure. Gold surged to fresh record highs as investors sought safe-haven assets amid rising geopolitical uncertainty and currency volatility, reinforcing a defensive shift towards precious metals and other hard-asset hedges.

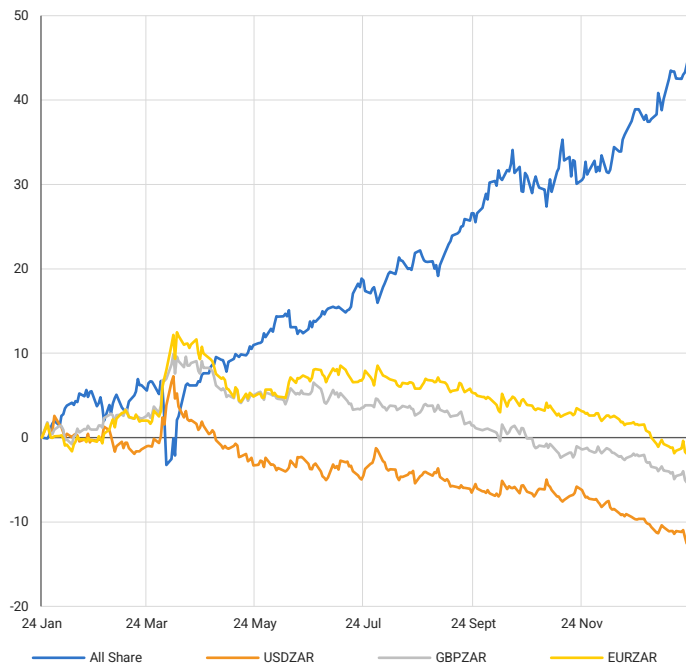
## CURRENCY MARKET SUMMARY

### SELECTED HEADLINES AND THEMES

The South African rand softened modestly but remained close to the 16-per-dollar level as markets positioned ahead of the upcoming central bank interest rate decision. Globally, the Japanese yen strengthened sharply, fuelling speculation around potential coordinated intervention and placing pressure on the US dollar. The euro traded at multi-month highs, while renewed yen and euro strength coincided with further gains in precious metals. Currency movements continue to reflect heightened sensitivity to policy signals, geopolitical risk and relative interest rate expectations across major markets.
