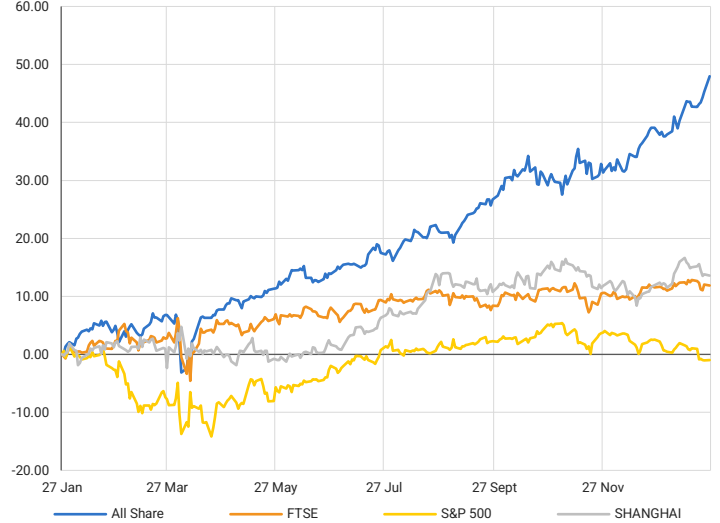

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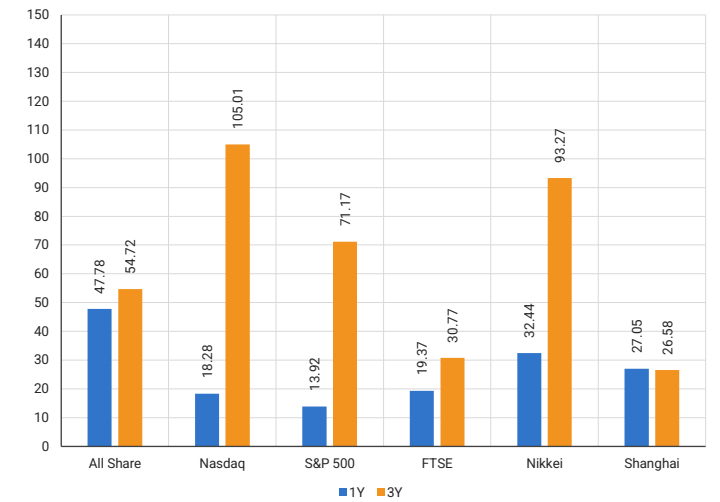

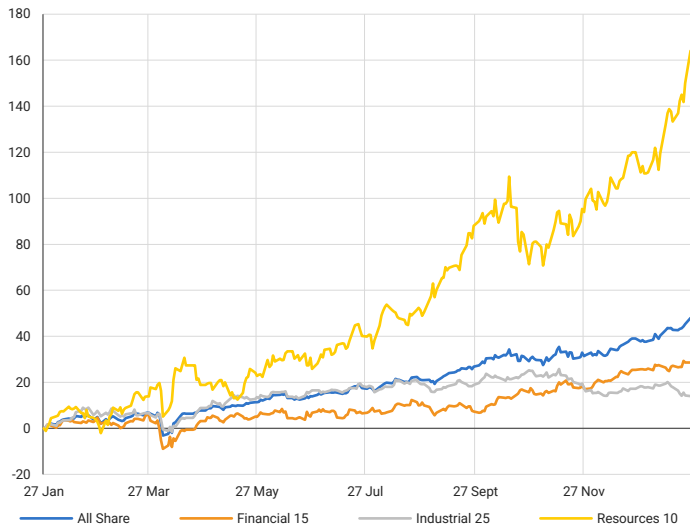
South African equities rallied strongly, with the JSE All Share climbing 1.87% to 124,563.48 and the Top 40 advancing 2.06% to 116,709.21, both new record closes. Gains were driven by firmer metal prices and rand strength, which buoyed resource stocks. Fiscal developments provided additional support after National Treasury signalled debt stabilisation relative to GDP and a third consecutive primary surplus. Prospects for a formal fiscal anchor and continued consolidation have lowered bond yields and bolstered the currency, reinforcing a recent ratings upgrade and improving medium-term sovereign risk perceptions.

Cashbuild – Soft Like-for-Like Sales Weigh on Update

Cashbuild reported a subdued second quarter for FY2026, with Group revenue increasing 1% year on year, supported by 15 new stores, while like-for-like sales from 309 existing outlets declined 2%. Transaction volumes rose 2%, but selling price inflation remained muted at 0.8%, pointing to limited pricing power. First-half revenue grew 3% on stronger first-quarter momentum. South Africa remained the key earnings base, while the broader African footprint delivered mixed results. The store base closed at 322 following openings, refurbishments, disposals and the Amper Alles consolidation.

Pan African Resources – Production Surge and Dividend Signal Strong Half

Pan African Resources delivered a robust H1FY26, with gold output rising 51% to 128,296oz, led by a sharp recovery at Evander, steady Barberton and Eikihulu production, and ramp-up at Tennant Mines. Net debt fell more than 65%, materially strengthening the balance sheet and supporting a proposed interim dividend of 12 cents per share. Although all-in sustaining costs were temporarily elevated by currency effects and once-off factors, higher second-half volumes are expected to ease unit costs. Expansion across tailings operations underpins medium-term production growth.

Spear REIT – Strong Letting Momentum Supports Upgraded Guidance

Spear REIT reported solid year-to-date performance to December 2025, with distributable income per share up 5.7% and revenue growth exceeding 20%, driven by acquisitions and firm leasing activity across its Western Cape-focused portfolio. Occupancy improved to 97.2%, with industrial assets continuing to anchor earnings while retail and office vacancies declined. Balance sheet metrics remained conservative, with loan-to-value at 25% and stronger interest cover. Management lifted full-year distributable income guidance to 5–6% growth, supported by rental traction, expanding solar income and easing borrowing costs.

EUROPEAN MARKET SUMMARY

SELECTED HEADLINES AND THEMES

European shares ended slightly higher, with financials leading ahead of a busy bank earnings calendar, lifting the STOXX 600 to a one-week high. Markets weighed constructive earnings expectations against persistent geopolitical and trade-policy risks. Sector performance diverged, as strength in banks offset weakness in aerospace, defence and parts of the consumer complex. Disappointing updates from Ryanair and Danone contrasted with a sharp rebound in Puma, underlining stock-specific volatility. Sentiment remains measured as investors assess tariff uncertainty and the resilience of Europe's earnings trajectory.

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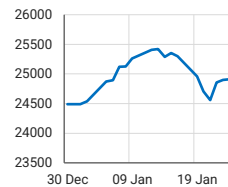

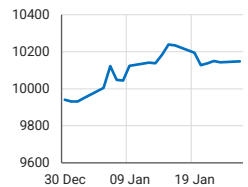

AMERICAN MARKET SUMMARY

SELECTED HEADLINES AND THEMES

US equities continued their advance, with the S&P 500 and Nasdaq registering a fourth consecutive gain, driven by mega-cap technology strength ahead of key earnings reports. Markets are assessing whether heavy AI-related investment is delivering tangible revenue and margin benefits, with elevated valuations increasing sensitivity to guidance. Earnings beats have been broad, but forward commentary remains critical. Focus now shifts to the Federal Reserve meeting, where policy is expected to remain unchanged, though investors will closely parse signals on the rate outlook and institutional independence.

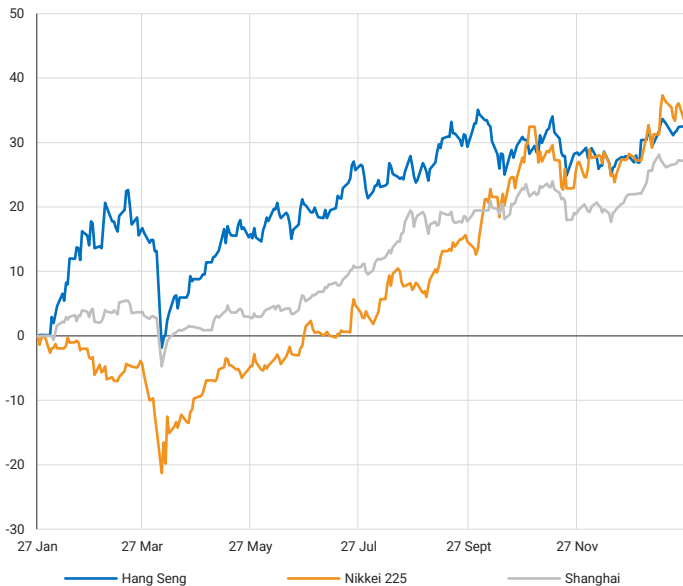

ASIAN MARKET SUMMARY

SELECTED HEADLINES AND THEMES

Asian markets contended with a blend of trade and policy developments. South Korean shares steadied after renewed US tariff rhetoric heightened trade tensions, while China reported a return to industrial profit growth as authorities acted to limit destructive price competition and support margins. Export strength continues to cushion weak domestic demand, although deflationary pressures linger. Pakistan's central bank surprised markets by holding rates steady, emphasising price stability over further easing. Regional sentiment remains sensitive to global demand dynamics and domestic policy credibility.

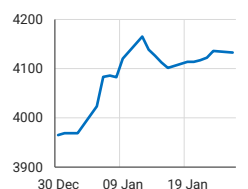

COMMODITIES MARKET SUMMARY

SELECTED HEADLINES AND THEMES

Oil prices eased despite notable US supply disruptions caused by severe winter weather, as traders balanced refinery outages against broader demand concerns and comfortable global supply. Geopolitical tensions remain in focus, with heightened US military presence in the Middle East and expectations that OPEC+ will maintain output discipline. Gold climbed to fresh record highs on sustained safe-haven demand amid geopolitical and currency uncertainty, while silver also remained firm. Commodity price action continues to be shaped more by supply risks and hedging flows than by clear demand acceleration.

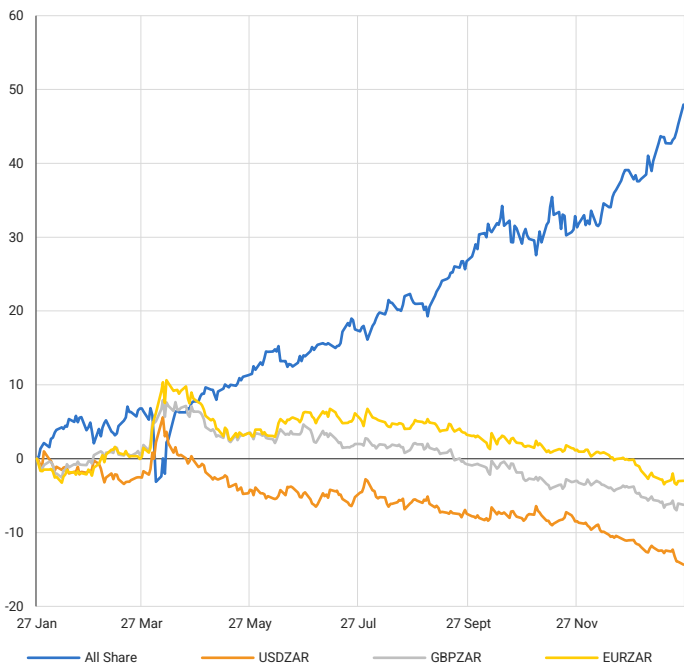

SELECTED HEADLINES AND THEMES

The rand strengthened to multi-year highs versus the dollar, supported by elevated precious metal prices and improving confidence in South Africa's fiscal outlook. The US dollar weakened broadly, weighed down by domestic political uncertainty, fiscal concerns and shifting policy expectations. The yen remained firm amid safe-haven flows and speculation around potential intervention. Currency markets are increasingly driven by policy credibility, geopolitical risk and relative growth differentials, with volatility elevated as investors reassess assumptions about dollar stability and the global interest-rate cycle.
