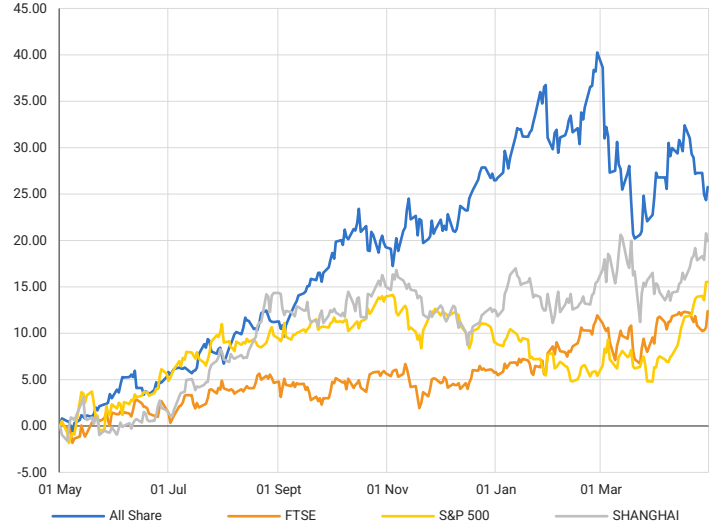

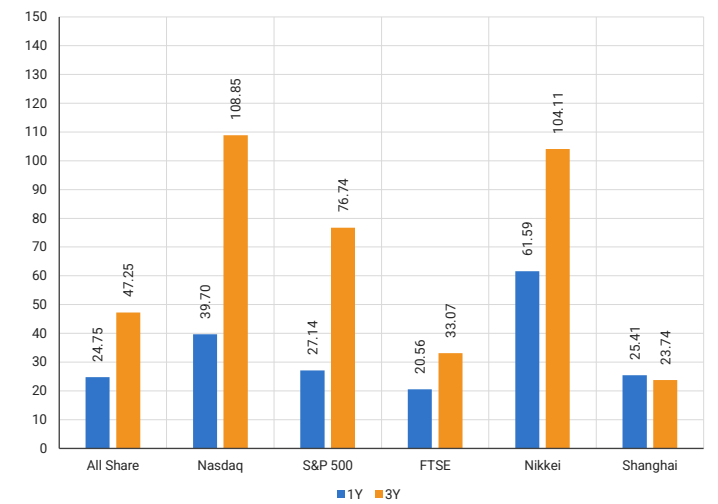

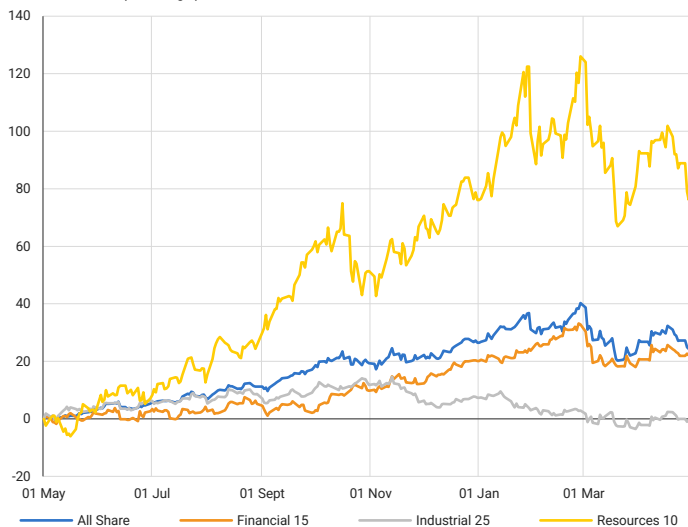
South African equities advanced on Thursday, with the All Share index rising 1.15% to 115,180.53 points and the Top 40 gaining 1.16% to 107,229.42 points, supported by firmer risk appetite. Producer inflation accelerated to 2.3% year-on-year in March, pointing to emerging pipeline pressures. The country recorded a trade surplus of R31.87 billion, while National Treasury reported a budget deficit of R45.61 billion, highlighting fiscal strain. Moody's relinquished its local licence, while Cyril Ramaphosa confirmed municipal elections for 4 November. Local markets were closed Friday for a public holiday, with prices reflecting Thursday's session.

Glencore plc – Production steady; pricing strength to drive margin expansion

Glencore plc reported first-quarter 2026 production broadly in line with expectations, maintaining full-year guidance despite cost pressures linked to Middle East supply disruptions. Copper output rose 19% to 199.6kt on improved grades, while cobalt, zinc and nickel declined due to mine closures and quota constraints. Energy coal remained broadly stable, while steelmaking coal fell on weather and sequencing impacts. Management expects stronger commodity prices to offset higher diesel and acid costs, supporting margins. Marketing EBIT is trending above the upper end of the \$2.3–\$3.5bn long-term range.

Santova Limited – Earnings guidance signals moderation off elevated base

Santova Limited guided to lower earnings for FY2026, with EPS expected between 102.56c and 108.32c and HEPS between 103.82c and 109.59c, reflecting declines of up to 11.1% and 9.9% respectively. The moderation follows a strong prior-year base and softer operational performance. The trading statement remains unaudited, with final results pending. The company also noted the release of statutory financials for its UK subsidiaries, including Seabourne entities, indicating transparency while potentially highlighting regional performance pressures. Overall, the outlook points to contained near-term earnings softness.

MC Mining Limited – Makhado nearing commissioning; strategic review at Uitkomst

MC Mining Limited delivered solid Q3 FY2026 progress, with the Makhado hard coking coal project on track for commissioning in May 2026, positioning it as South Africa's largest HCC operation. Safety performance improved, while Uitkomst Colliery was suspended to assess strategic options, including potential partnerships. Thermal and coking coal prices strengthened, supporting project economics. Liquidity improved to US\$5.4 million, with continued IDC debt repayments. Kinetic Development Group increased its stake to 51%, reinforcing funding certainty and enhancing execution visibility ahead of production ramp-up.

2025 vs 2026



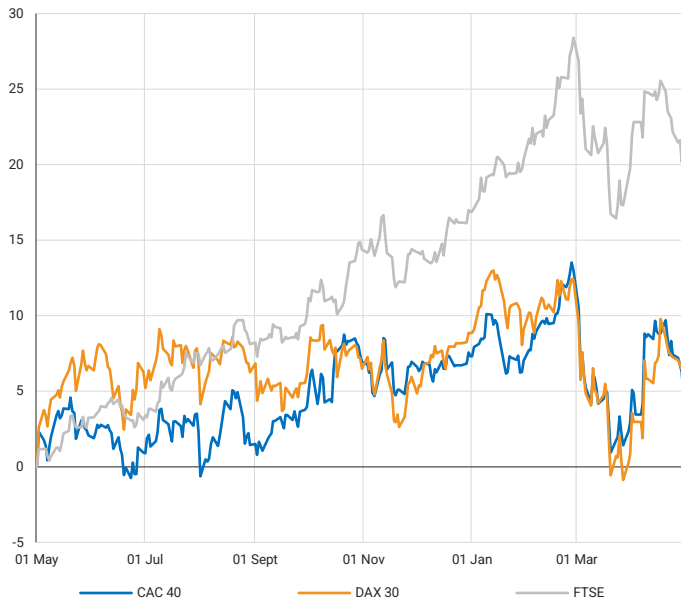

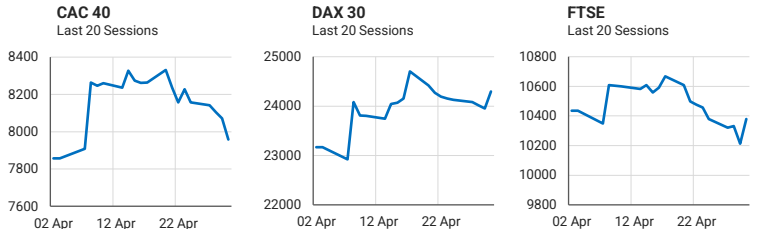

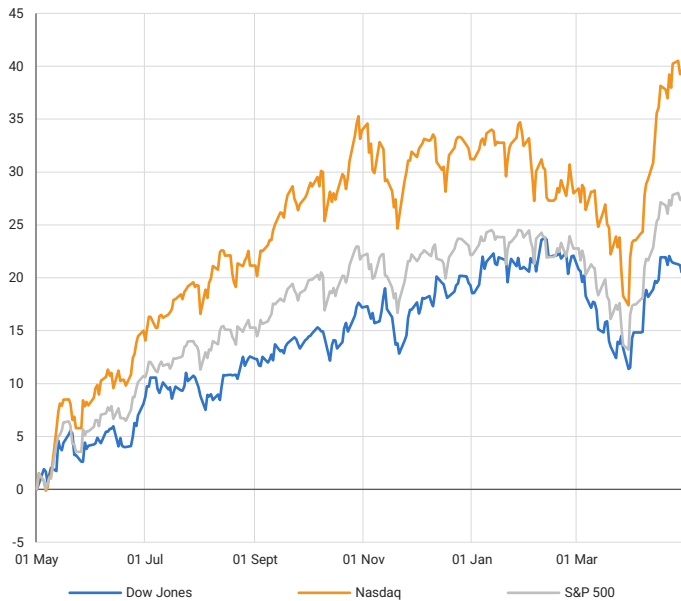
SELECTED HEADLINES AND THEMES

London's FTSE 100 closed slightly lower on Friday, pressured by weakness in energy stocks and AstraZeneca, which fell 3.1% following a negative regulatory development. NatWest declined 3.4% despite a 12% rise in first-quarter profit, as non-interest income disappointed. Trading volumes were subdued ahead of a UK public holiday, with most European markets closed, limiting liquidity. Nevertheless, LSEG data points to improving earnings momentum, with STOXX 600 companies expected to deliver 3.8% year-on-year growth excluding energy.

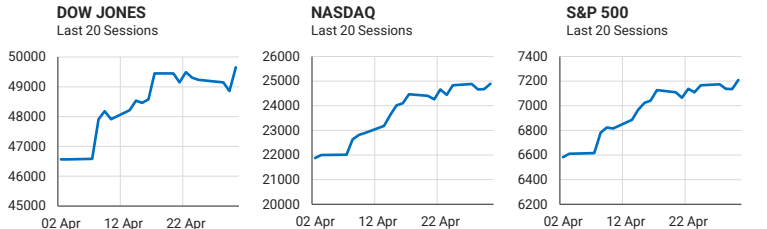

SELECTED HEADLINES AND THEMES

U.S. equities advanced on Friday, with the S&P 500 and Nasdaq Composite closing at record highs, supported by robust earnings and softer crude prices, while the Dow Jones Industrial Average edged lower. Both indices posted a sixth consecutive weekly gain, the longest streak since October 2024. Earnings momentum remains strong, with LSEG data showing 83% of companies beating estimates. However, Institute for Supply Management data signalled rising inflation pressures, keeping market positioning sensitive.

Normalised percentage performances

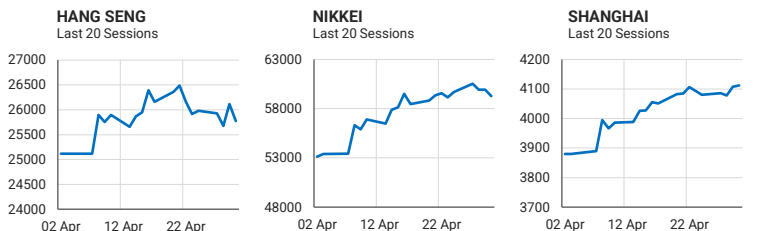

SELECTED HEADLINES AND THEMES

South Korean equities advanced on Monday, with the KOSPI reaching a fresh record following strong April gains, as investors weighed solid domestic data against geopolitical risks. Manufacturing momentum strengthened, with the Purchasing Managers' Index rising to 53.6, its highest level since February 2022, supported by semiconductor demand. The Bank of Korea signalled a more hawkish stance, indicating potential rate hikes as growth remains resilient and inflation trends higher, marking a shift towards policy normalisation.

Gold prices edged lower on Monday in thin trading, pressured by persistent inflation concerns weighing on the U.S. policy outlook. Oil prices eased modestly but remained above \$100 per barrel, supported by ongoing geopolitical tensions. Comments from Donald Trump on reopening shipping routes in the Strait of Hormuz offered limited relief, as the absence of a U.S.-Iran agreement continues to constrain supply. OPEC+ confirmed a 188,000 bpd output increase for June, although disruptions suggest much of the additional supply may remain unrealised.

SELECTED HEADLINES AND THEMES

The South African rand strengthened on Thursday as investors assessed domestic data for signs of economic resilience. The Japanese yen stabilised after recent volatility, supported by suspected intervention from the Bank of Japan, though sustainability remains uncertain. The U.S. dollar index was broadly flat amid cautious positioning. The euro edged higher after Friedrich Merz sought to ease tensions with the U.S. over trade policy. Remarks from Donald Trump on Strait of Hormuz shipping access added to geopolitical sensitivity, keeping FX markets range-bound.
